EDWARD TITCHENER

- 11 January 1867 - 3 August 1927
- his occupation was a psychologist
- he is also remembered for coining the english word empathy in 1909
- he is best known for creating a version of psychology that described the structure of the mind
- he wrote "A Textbook of Psychology"

Titchener had been a student of Wundt's, and used introspection in his laboratory at Cornell University. He had been studying Wundt's basic elements of consciousness, as well as other aspects of this that are harder to quantify. One being him adding "clearness" as an element of sensation

His brain was contributed to the wilder brain collection at Cornelle
