SIGMUND FRUED



- May 6, 1856 - September 23, 1939
- Occupation: Physician
- Theory - All behavior and mental processes have physical causes somewhere in the nervous system
- Frued became convinced, after interviewing patients using hypnosis and other methods, that these people's physical problems were not physical.
- Frued eventually became to believe that all behavior is motivated by psychological processes.
- Psychoanalysis is the theory of personality and mental disorders, as well as a set of treatment methods.
- Sigmund Frued created the school of Psychoanalysis.
