

Ideas for We Do Activities Cause and Effect

- Have students code a piece text, labeling “C” for cause and “E” for effect.
- Have students make cause and effect inferences from a graph.
- Have students brainstorm reasons why something occurred. Be certain that students understand that reasons are causes.
- Have students make inferences about the causes of an effect they can see in a photograph.
- Have students rank order causes to determine which had the greater effect.
- Have students make inferences about the events that caused a cartoonist to draw a specific editorial cartoon.
