Role: News Editor

Description: News editors oversee the content that makes up a publication. They work for newspapers, magazines and websites, and handle a wide array of duties. That includes assigning stories to reporters and photographers, editing content, and writing headlines and photo captions. Most news editors work with managers of other departments, such as city and sports editors, to coordinate coverage and decide on placement for stories.

Task: Your first assignment is to arrange content on a newspaper page so that readers can quickly and easily understand the information. According to research, readers prefer articles that have been arranged by organizational structure. You must arrange the articles in the following order: chronological order, compare/contrast, cause/effect, problem/solution. In order to help readers understand how to read the article, you will also need to highlight words that signal the organizational structure and provide information about how to determine which structure is being used.
