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Talking Word Processor (Premier Software)

Key Features:

- Designed to support all readers in giving them access to print material
- Import text from any source—typed, scanned-in text, Internet files, word processing files
- Reads/Highlights letters, selected text, or complete text
- Select volume, speed, and pitch of reading voices
- Control movement through the text (auto or manual) by word, sentence, paragraph
- Set the style, color, size of text and color of background
- Provides word prediction to assist in spelling/word recall

Getting Started:

- Open Talking Word Processor
- Type text into file
- Position cursor at beginning of text to be read
- Select the Read button in the Menu bar to start reading (or press F6)
- Select Stop Button to stop reading (or press F7—if you press F6 again it will start reading where you stopped)
- Using the right or left arrow, it will read one letter at a time
- Using the CTRL key and right or left arrow, it will read one word at a time
- To change Voice and voice features, select Voices icon from menu bar: control voice, speed (F12) and pitch
- Select Reading Options from Read in Menu bar to change background or text color, tracking by word, sentence, paragraph,
- To increase/decrease line or word spacing, or to zoom in or out, select View from Menu, then select your choice
- To use Word Prediction, press CTRL W, or select Prediction from Menu

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Universal Reader (Premier Software)

Key Features:

- Reads text from any source—typed, scanned-in text, e-mail, Internet files, word processing files
- Floating toolbar shows up on top of whatever application you are using
- Select volume, speed, and pitch of reading voices
- Control movement through the text by word, sentence, paragraph
- Set the style, color, size of text and color of background
- Repeats Words as you type them into any application
- Adjustable speaking speed and pitch
- Scans any hardcopy text and retains all original page content and images
- View window - Displays what is being read
- Highlights the word as it is read



Getting Started:

- Open Universal Reader
- Open internet page or file of text to be read
- Highlight text and click on the read button.
- To Stop reading click on the Stop (Stoplight) button
- To stop it temporarily, click on the Pause.
- Click on Rewind button to take you back to the beginning and start reading again.
- Change Voice Settings from Voices Button

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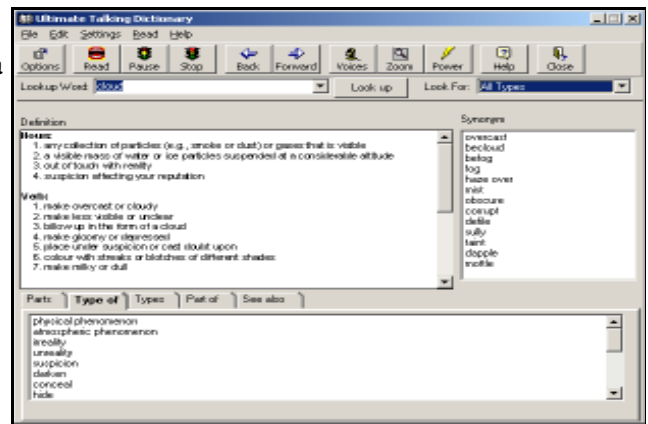
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Talking Dictionary (Premier Software)

Key Features:

- reads the definition and uses the word in a sentence so that you will get a true understanding of the word.
- contains over 250,000 words, including slang, jargon, and historic figures
- Uses word prediction "predict" the word you are trying to spell and present you with a list of potential matches
- has a fully integrated thesaurus
- Uses power search to look up a word: Example: start by looking up "sky"; you can view all the **parts of** the sky ie. "rainbow" and "clouds"; select "clouds" then view **types of** clouds; find a definition of an acorn just by looking up the word "tree".



Getting Started:

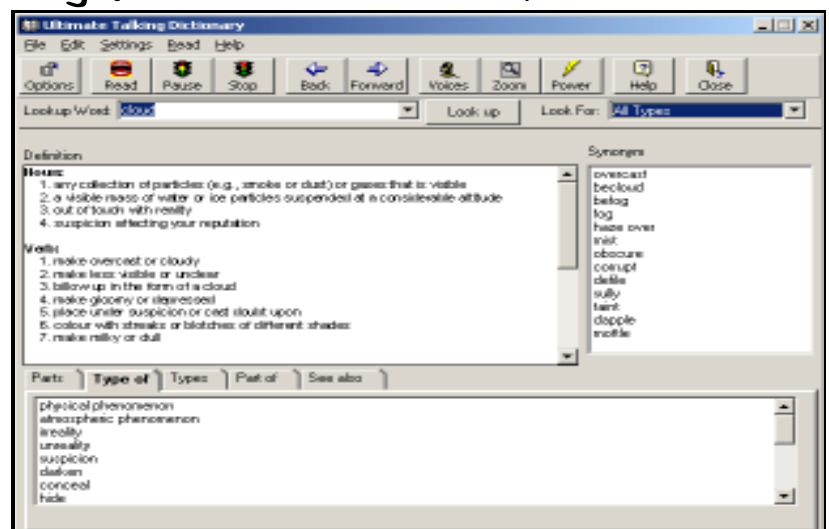
- Open Talking Dictionary
- Type the word and click on *Look Up*
- To run in the background, load UTD once. Activate it just by pressing CTRL+F12.
- From any application, highlight a word you want to look up, press the F11 key UTD finds the word
- Change Voice Settings from Voices Button

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E-Text Reader (Premier Software)

Key Features:

- **Highlights and tracks** each word as it reads.
- **Change Foreground and Background colors.**
- **Adjustable Reading Speeds.**
- **Reading pace.** Read one word at a time or continuously.
- **Bookmarks.** Insert bookmarks to mark locations in the text.
- **Highlighting Features.** Use the built-in highlighters to highlight text for studies and review.
- **Highlight Extraction.** Use the extraction feature to extract only highlighted information (even multiple colors).
- **Extract Highlighted Text by Color.** Users can extract all highlighted text or only one color.
- **Read only Highlighted Text.** E-Text Reader can be directed to read only highlighted text.
- **Audio books.** Bookmarks are compatible with Text-to-Audio when creating audio books.



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
