

## Code of Student Conduct

Students of the Renfrew County District School Board are expected to demonstrate a commitment to the core values reflected in the Code of Conduct, and character traits such as:

Integrity  
Courage  
Optimism

In acting to these character traits, students will bring credit to themselves, their families and their school. Each student is expected to:

- Be neat and clean in person and habits;
- Be kind and courteous to fellow students;
- Use proper, acceptable language at all times;
- Be co-operative and respectful to all staff members and volunteers;
- Have respect for personal and public property;
- Exhibit honesty and responsibility in personal obligations;
- Be responsible for personal conduct on school premises, on school buses and during all extracurricular functions; and
- Refrain from smoking and the use of tobacco products, drugs, intoxicating inhalants, alcohol and near-beer or wine anywhere including on school trips or excursions and at school-related functions.
