1. Trip Schedule:

Report to Freedom at 7:30 a.m.

Lunch at the park - \$14.75 in meal tickets included
Afternoon in the park with chaperones and check ins
Awards ceremony 6 p.m.
Depart for home 6:45 p.m.
Arrive home 8:30 p.m. - barring any construction:)

2. Performance attire:

Red shirt from Pops concert
black pants or black skirt (nothing tight or short, dress professionally, no jeans, sweats, short skirts)
black dress shoes (no sneakers or boots)

3. Park attire:

Bring a change of clothes and bathing suit (appropriate bathing suit for the water park) for the rest of the day. We will have a chance to change at the school before heading to the park. Bring comfortable shoes, sandals for the day. We will be leaving our performance clothes and bags on the bus and will not be carrying them through the park.
