Debra is a GODSEND! Here's what she gave me:

Following the manual, p. 14-15 works IF you have WLAN Power in your control panel.
Mine didn't, so...

Tap the little icon in the taskbar that looks like a circle with a line. (It will be gray.)

Tap the Status tab and make sure the radio is turned on.

Click the Config tab:

If FHSD is on the list, tap it then tap Activate.

If not, tap New

Use the input panel to tap in SSID: FHSD (all caps! Lowercase doesn't work!)

Assoc. mode: select WEP and 64 bits and HEX

Key: our 10-character password (afxxxxxxxx; call me if you need it)

Close the input panel and tap OK.

Mine connected immediately!
