

NoodleTools Tip Sheet – Advanced

Database: Annals of America

NoodleTools formats each database slightly differently, depending upon the original format of the content. Use this tip sheet if:

You have a source from The Annals of America database

If you have a source from the print series, use citation Form B

Anatomy of Annals of America database source citations

Format:

Author. "Article/entry title." *Title of reference database.* **URL.** Date of access

Example:

Benjamin Franklin. "Advice to a Young Tradesman." *Annals of American History.*

http://www.america.eb.com (shortened) **Web** Accessed **Jan. 13, 2011.**

NoodleTools will request the information in the same order in which it is listed on your citation. NoodleTools may ask for additional information. Include only the information that is listed in your citation.

Annals of America

Select: Electronic / Online



Select: Cite a: and Create Citation



NoodleTools will ask:

- Original Content?

Select: No, this is a reproduction of a work published elsewhere. Select the publication type of the original work:

- ☒ Reference Source and NEXT

NoodleTools will ask:

- Tell us more about this source
- What type of reference source is this?

Select:

- ☒ Other (e.g. thesaurus, almanac, yearbook)

NoodleTools will ask:

- What content are you citing?

Select:

- ☒ an article or an entry

NoodleTools will ask:

- Is the online material duplicated from a printed work?

Select:

- ☒ Yes. I will provide the publication details of the original print publication in my citation

And select NEXT



Fill in the information as prompted

- consult your source citation for appropriate source information
- include only the information listed on your source citation
- **Note:** Under “Basic Information” you will be asked to include the “title of the reference book”. This information is not listed in your citation printout but needs to be included in NoodleTools. *For “title of book” enter Annals of America*

- Do not enter any information under the section “Information about the Print Reference Source.”:
- For the name of the database select:
 - **Select** *Choose from my library’s list of databases.* From the Online databases drop-down menu select

Online databases:

Complete the Annotation at the bottom of the form and check for errors.



Check for errors and Generate citation. Double check against source citation.

Note: For National History Day Annotated Works Consulted (aka Annotated Bibliography) return to your NoodleTools Works Cited page to select primary and secondary source attributes.

To select attributes:

1. Click on the box to the left of your source.
2. At the bottom of the page, select the drop down Attributes box
3. Select “primary” or “secondary” to describe the source
4. Click on “apply”

Before converting to a Word doc, you will need to select “primary /secondary” at the sort box on the upper right.
