


## NoodleTools Tip Sheet – Advanced FORM A – Non-Fiction

**If you have Form A (a non-fiction book)**

Select: Nonperiodicals

Select Cite as:  and Create Citation



*NoodleTools will ask:*

- We think you probably mean...



### **Book**

- an entire book or section of a book
- a printed book reproduced on electronic media
- a map or chart
- a photograph or illustration
- a graphic novel or comic book
- a scholarly edition of a classic work
- a transcript of an interview or speech

Select “Book” as above and “Next.”



*NoodleTools will ask:*

- What is the publication medium of this source?

Select:



**Print:** Printed book



*NoodleTools will ask:*

- Tell us more about this source
- What content of the book are you citing?

Select:

- ☒ The entire book (note: you will not be prompted to enter page numbers)  
(Note: select “entire book” even if you used only a portion of the non-fiction book)

Select: “Next”



- Complete Basic Information Only, up to Publication Year.
- *NoodleTools* will ask two questions:

\* Does the source have page numbers?

Select “yes”. (You will not enter any page numbers; selecting “yes” ensures that “n.p” will not appear in your AWC)

\* Is this a *scholarly edition*?

Select “no” for above



- Do not complete Additional Information.



- Complete the Annotation at the bottom of the form and check for errors.



- Generate Citation

**Note:** For National History Day Annotated Works Consulted (aka Annotated Bibliography) return to your NoodleTools Works Cited page to select primary and secondary source attributes.

To select attributes:

1. Click on the box to the left of your source.
2. At the bottom of the page, select the drop down Attributes box
3. Select “primary” or “secondary” to describe the source
4. Click on “apply”

Before converting to a Word doc, you will need to select “primary /secondary” at the sort box on the upper right.
