



Your ExploreLearning Class Tabs

- Review the Gizmos you currently have on your class tabs that correlate to your curriculum. Consider deleting those that are no longer relevant or you do not wish to have on your class tab – just click on the circular X that corresponds to the Gizmo.
- To delete several Gizmos at the time, or to organize the Gizmos, use the “Manage Gizmo List” feature. First select the Gizmo you wish from the list by clicking on it. Then, use the up/down arrows to put in order or the red X to delete. You can also add headers to categorize Gizmos on your class tab. Don’t forget to click “Save” in the bottom right corner on the “Manage Gizmo List” screen when finished.
- As you start to strategically plan units/lessons, search for Gizmos by using the “Browse Gizmos” feature on the blue navigation bar at the top of the screen. Browse by textbook, academic standard, grade/topic, or keyword. Refer to district curriculum guides, which may have recommended Gizmos.
- Finally, don’t forget to work smarter, not harder! If you teach the same class/prep multiple times throughout the school day, consider organizing all your Gizmos under just one class tab. Organize your Gizmos the way you want them using the “Manage Gizmos” feature, and add headers if you wish. Once finished, take advantage of the “Import Gizmos” feature to copy all the Gizmos, their organization, and headers added to other class tabs.

- As part of your school’s School Improvement Plan (SIP), consider documenting Gizmos use in math and science courses as a teaching tool or resource. Be sure to include any district level Gizmos training that is available for teacher’s professional development.
