Note In ContentKeeper, an Image is a URL ending with one of the following file type suffixes: (.jpg, .jpeg, .gif, .bmp, .png)

Google Thumb Images

For Google Thumb Images, if the Image is NOT in the Allow or the Non-Managed state but classified as Adult Content it will be replaced with the first image, while those classified in all other Categories will be replaced with the second image.



Force Google into Strict Filtering

Google's **SafeSearch** blocks web pages containing explicit sexual content from appearing in search results.

See [Google's Safe Search](#) facility for more information.

ContentKeeper can force Google to operate in **Strict Filtering** (mode 1) for Web Search, Images and Groups when enabled. (Set to **Yes**)

When disabled (Set to **No**), no interference occurs with Google's SafeSearch facility.

Image Components

If a URL has an Allow or Non-Managed state, its image components may contain URLs that are classified and blocked.

(e.g) A Business Oriented site set to allow that displays Advertising Images. If the Advertising Category is set to block then the Advertising Images will be replaced with the following image.



HTTP Header Error Code

When a Block Page is generated the HTTP error header may contain the HTTP error code 200 or 403.
That is, either **HTTP/1.0 403 Forbidden** or **HTTP/1.1 200 OK**.

JavaScript URL Option

When a Blocked URL has the JavaScript File Extension (*.js or /js.*) the response can be either HTML
(The Block Page)
or a empty (NULL) JavaScript File. Sending HTML to JavaScript URLs may generate popup error
messages in
some browsers because the browser is expecting JavaScript, not HTML.

Coach Block Page Frequency for all Sites

Once a site is accessed through a **Coach** Block Page, the Coach **Block** will re-appear
after this many seconds.
Prior to Version 123.10 the hard coded Block Page Frequency was always 60 seconds.

Coach Block Page for SSL Sites

Some SSL sites (e.g. Internet Banking Sites) have access restrictions based on the referrer site.
Using a **Redirect** Custom Block Page may make it impossible to Access these SSL Sites.
Use this option to redefine your **Coach** Block Page to either **Simple** or **Default**.

Adult Classification overrides other Categories

A URL classified in the special categories **News** (2), **Search Sites** (20), **Business** (24) and/or
Educational (26)
as well as some other Category (except Government Blocking List (25) and Advertising (27))
will generally be filtered based on the above special categories when this option is set to **Yes**.
This is the normal Default Behaviour.
Setting this option to **No** will cause filtering to be applied to the first matching category 1,2,3,4....32,
checked in this order.
(e.g.) If a URL is classified in Adult Content (1) and Search Sites (20), then if the option is set to:
Yes: Then the **Search Site** Category will be applied.
No: Then the **Adult Content** Category will be applied.
