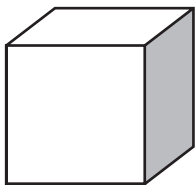


1. Mr. Robertson drove 235 miles last week. This week he drove another 379 miles. What is the total number of miles Mr. Robertson has driven in two weeks?
