

# Multiplication Stories

1. To have fresh eggs I bought 12 chickens. The chickens cost \$15 each. How much did I spend altogether?

Answer: \$180. **Correct**

2. Lee has won a prize at the local music store. He can choose how to take his prize. He can have either 30 CD'S straight away or 1 CD every Friday for the next five months. Which choice should Lee make? **Correct**

Answer: He should take the 30 CD'S straight away.

3. Environmentalists estimate that rainforest trees are cut down at the rate of 100 trees per minute. If this is true, how many are cut down every day? Every week?

Answer: 144,000 per day and 1,008,000 per week. **Both correct.**

4. Our school cleaner has to buy new stoppers for the legs of all the chairs in our class. How many would she have to buy ?

Answer: 44 **wrong**

4 of my friends each gave me 25 connectors. How many did I get altogether? 100

My mum gave me 6 napkins to lay out and 6 cups to lay out and 6 paper plates. How many things did I have to lie out? 18.
