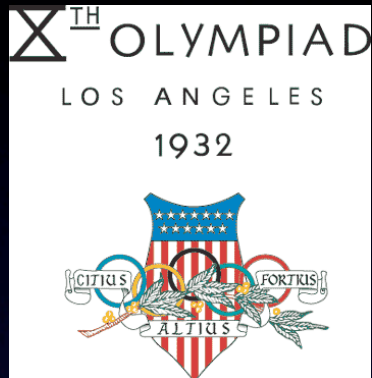


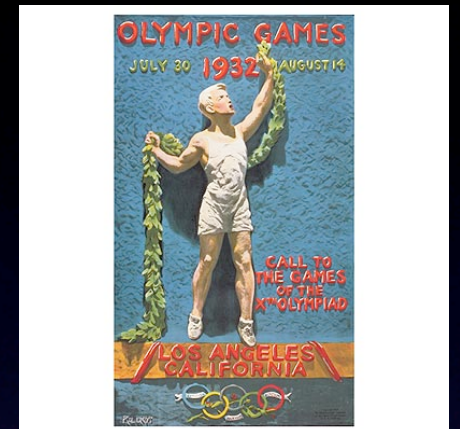
Los Angeles - 1932

37 countries were represented at these games. There were 1,337 athletes competing (126 women and 1,206 men) in 117 events.



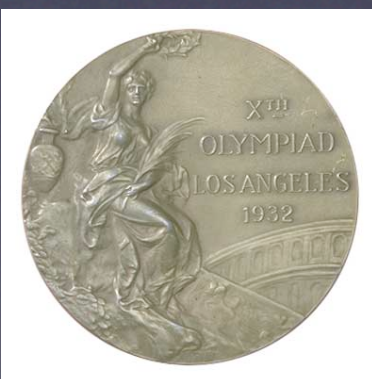
The Poster

Interesting Fact

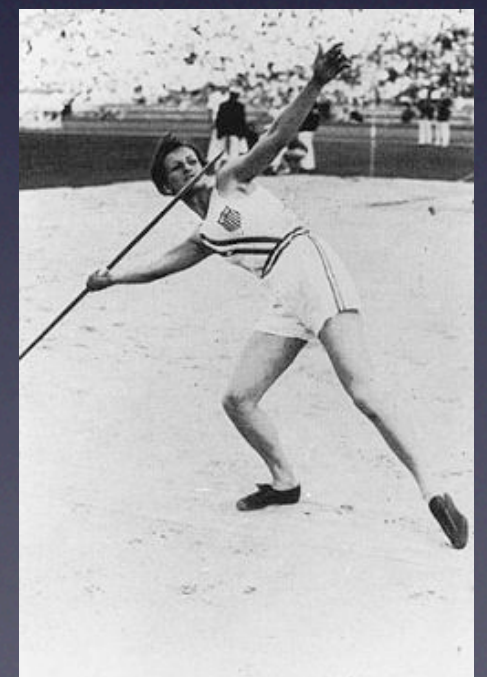
Because of the Great Depression and Los Angeles was considered so far away there were not as many athletes competing as the previous Olympics games 4 years earlier.

Highlight from the Games

An athlete from USA called "Babe" Didrikson won three medals. One in the Javelin, one in the 80 metres hurdles and the other in the high jump. She could have won more but women were only allowed to enter 3 events back then.
