



LMC ereader Permissions and Acceptable Use Contract

The ereader is a convenient electronic, portable reading device. It is the size of a paperback and capable of holding up to 1,300 books. The chance to use this device is a privilege that we are able to provide to students in 3rd thru 8th grade provided that the students use extra caution and responsibility. Students in 3rd thru 8th grades will be allowed to check out ereaders and take them home for use. Each ereader is valued at \$130.00 (includes cost of cover). For this reason we require a parental signature on this form before an ereader can be loaned to a student.

Parent Responsibilities and Permission

I am authorizing my child to check out an ereader. I understand that it is to be used as a tool for reading and learning and that my child will comply with all terms outlined in this contract. I will help ensure the safe and timely return of the ereader within the loan period. **I understand that I am financially responsible if my student loses the device. Additionally, I am financially responsible for any willful, malicious, or accidental damage to the ereader as well as any charges resulting from content or applications downloaded to the ereader. I will ensure that my student understands NOT to enable the Wi-Fi or "lend" ereader content.** I understand that my child may lose future loan privileges of the device if the ereader is either damaged or not returned in a timely manner.

I will not "lend" content on the ereader. I will use the ereader in an appropriate manner. **I will NOT turn on the Wi-Fi or download any content to the ereader.** I will return the ereader in good condition at the conclusion of the loan period. **I agree to return the ereader directly to the LMC circulation desk, I will not return it by using the LMC drop slot.** I will promptly report any issues with the device to the Teacher-Librarian.
