Flag of Hispanic & Latin American People



Adopted 12 October 1932 - Designed by Angel Cambor
The Flag of the Hispanic People
(Spanish: Bandera de la Hispanidad),
is a flag sometimes used to represent the Hispanic people.

The Hispanic flag is a white flag with 3 purple crosses & a rising sun.
The three purple cross pattées symbolize Christopher Columbus'
three ships, the Niña, the Pinta, and the Santa María.

They also symbolize Christianity.
The golden sun symbolizes the awakening of the new lands on a white
field (symbolizing peace and purity).

The purple color of the crosses comes from the ancient
use of this color in the lion of the Kingdom of León,
where the Spanish language was born.
