3. Once the file has completed its download, open the Adobe Connect meeting Room, select:

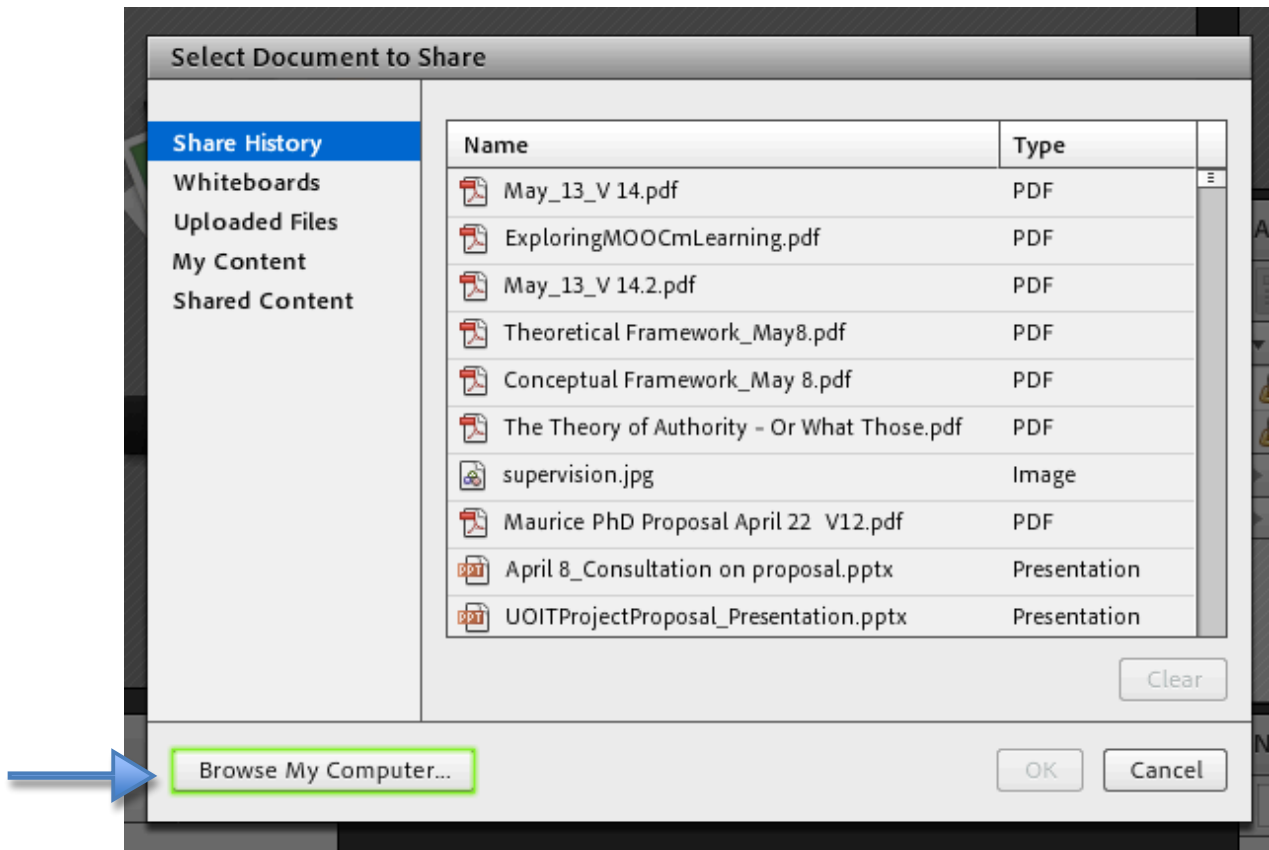
Pods → Share → Add New Share



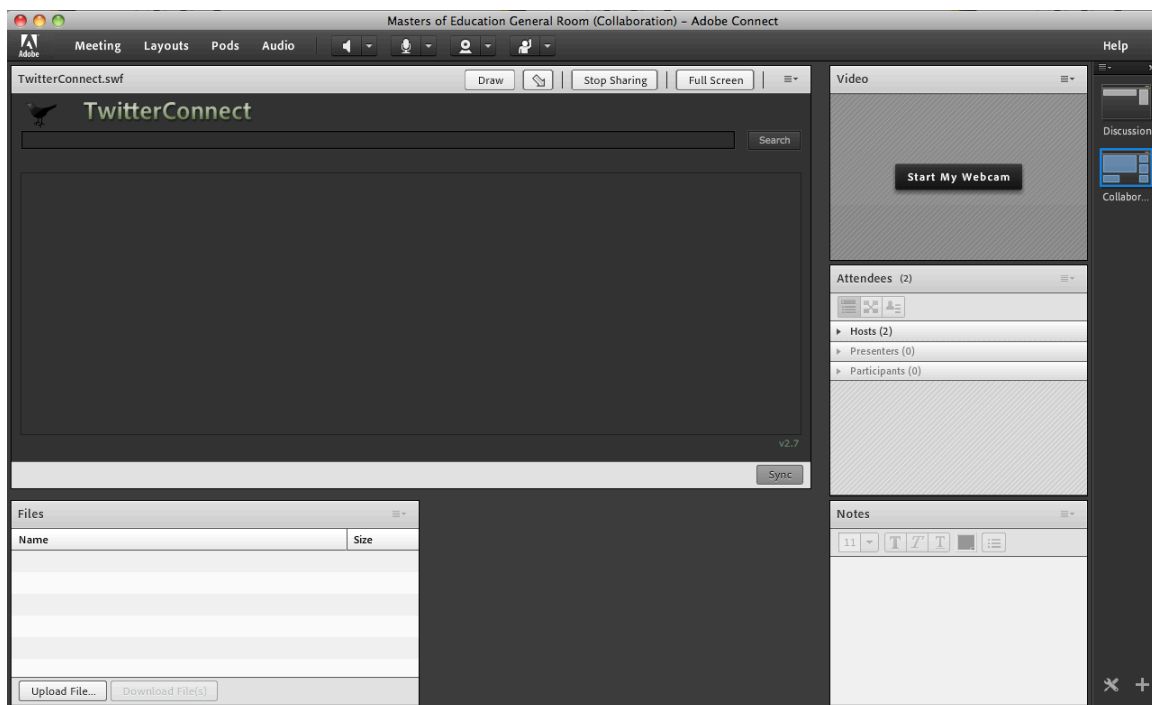
4. Under Share My Screen, select Share Document:



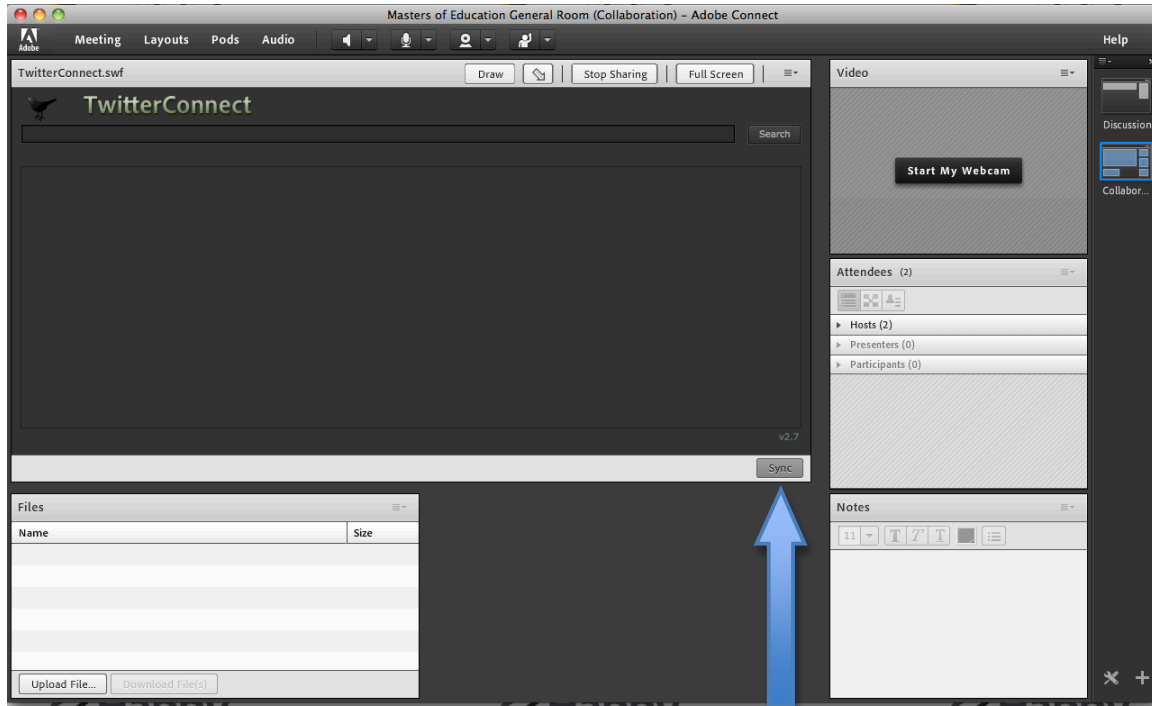
If the file does not exist on the current list, you must click on the Browse My Computer button to locate the “TwitterConnect.swf” file:



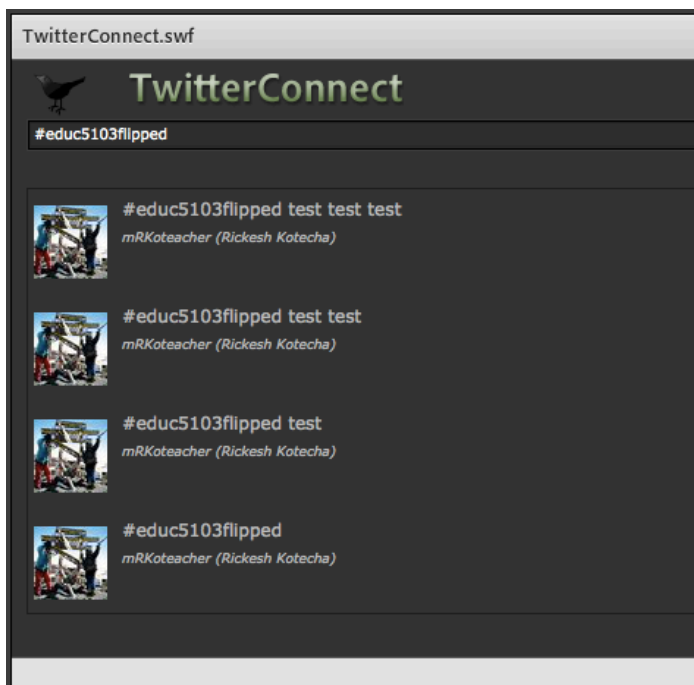
5. Once located on your computer, click Open and the application should automatically appear in the Adobe Connect Meeting:



6. Ensure that the “Sync” button is pressed:



7. In the search box, enter in any hash tag you would like to follow and click search. Any new tweets with this hash tag will automatically be updated:



* Note: if the hash tag does not show up, compose another tweet with the same hash tag; the more tweets that exist (with the hash tag) the quicker the application will be able to feed the messages!
