

Adobe Photoshop: Adding and Manipulating Text

Adding Text:

1. Click on the text tool (T) on your tool bar.
2. Click somewhere on your image.
3. Begin typing.

To change the font or size:

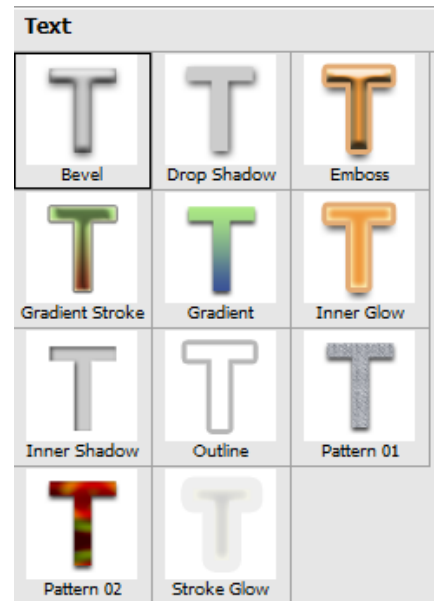
1. Click on the move tool (arrow at the top).
2. Double click on the text you wish to change. A text tool bar should open at the top of the screen. Choose your font, text size, color and style using this toolbar.



3. You can also change the size by clicking on the text once and dragging the corners in or out.

To add a special effect to the text:

1. The artwork and effects window should be open to the right of the screen. If it is not, go to window, select artwork and effect.
2. Click on the “T” in this window. Several Ts should appear below in the window.
3. Click on the text you wish to add an effect to, then double click on the effect (T) in the window.
4. The effect should appear immediately after you double click.



To “Warp” the text:

1. Click on the text you wish to warp.
2. Go to Layer, Type, Warp Text.
3. In the dialogue box, click on the arrow next to where it says “none”.
4. Many types of warping effects should pop up. Choose the one that you wish to use.
5. Manipulate the warping by sliding the buttons right and left.
6. Press ok when you are complete.
