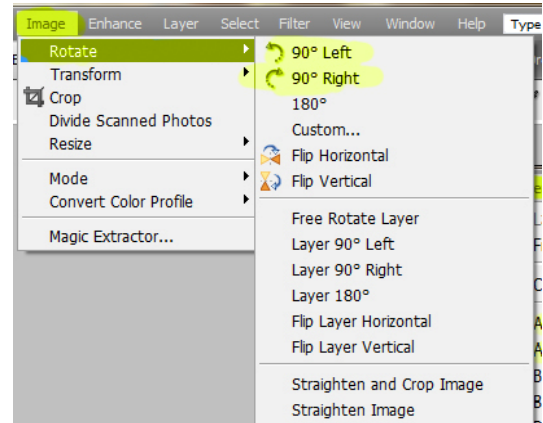


# Adobe Photoshop: Rotating, Distorting, Highlights and Shadows, and Filters

## Rotating Images:

### Directions:

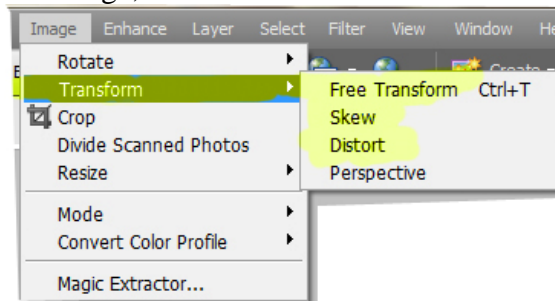
1. To rotate the orientation of your image, go to Image, Rotate.
2. Select on the correct rotation directions.



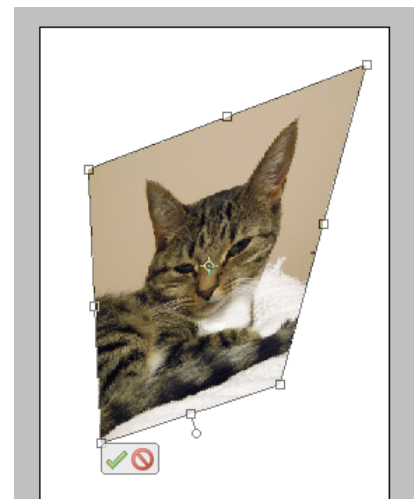
## Transforming Images:

### Directions:

1. To distort or skew layers or objects, go to Image, Transform.



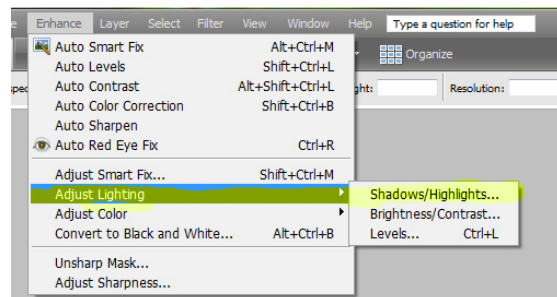
2. You will have four options under Transform: Free transform, skew, distort, and perspective, each transforming in a different way.



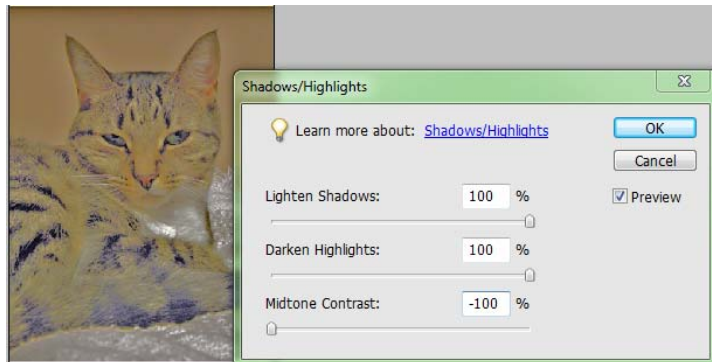
## Changing Highlights and Shadows:

### Directions:

1. To change the highlights, shadows, and midtones, go to Enhance, Adjust Lighting, Highlights/Shadows.



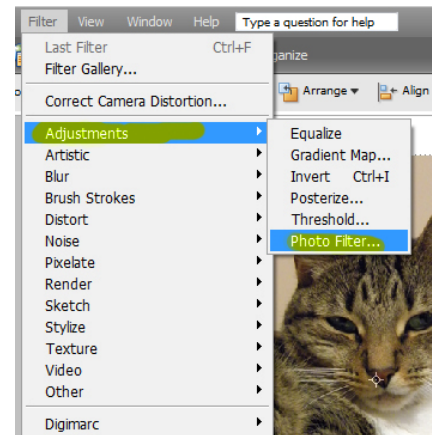
- Adjust each by sliding the button from one side to another.



## Filters:

**Photo Filter:** Giving the photo a color filter.

- Go to Filter, Adjustments, Photofilter.
- Click on the down arrow to select the color of the filter.
- Change the density to make the filter less or more.



**Other Filters:** There are many other artistic filters that create a variety of interesting effects.

- Go to Filter, Artistic, and choose any of the choices.
- A dialogue box will pop up. Here you can preview the filter, change the levels of the filter, and preview other filters.
- Press OK when you have found the filter of your choice.
