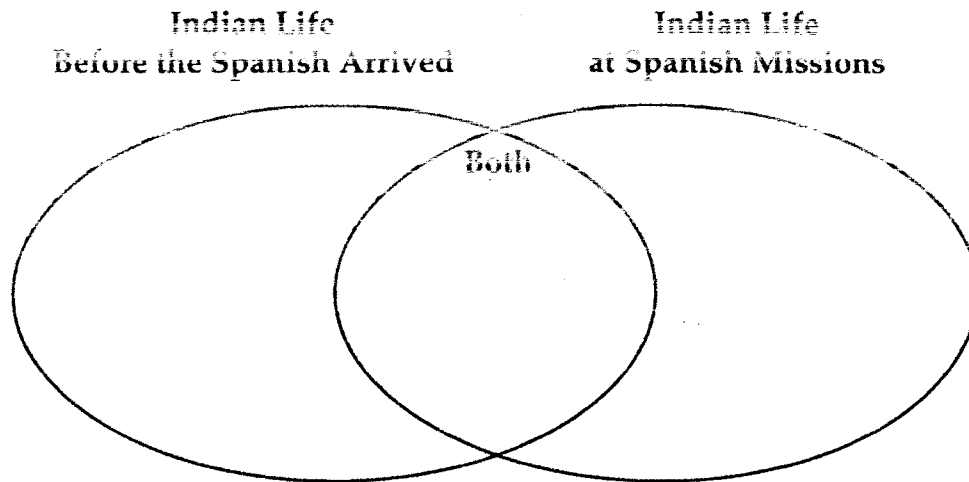


MISSIONS BRING CHANGES

- H. Native Floridians grew watermelons and oranges.
- I. Native Floridians raised horses, sheep, and cows.
- J. Indians often died from diseases brought from Europe.
- K. Native Floridians constructed buildings using natural resources.
