

## **GARAGEBAND PODCAST/DIGITAL STORY – 50 POINTS**

A podcast is a digital recording that can be created using your computer or even with an iPad and uploaded to the internet. These recordings can be listened to on a computer and/or downloaded to an MP3 player such as an iPod for listening. You will be asked to create a podcast individually or as a team of 2.

Ideas for podcasts include the following:

- How to \_\_\_\_\_. (Can apply to any topic across the curriculum). Create as a guide for students or teachers.
- Interview a partner. StoryCorp has a great list of questions arranged by topic at <http://nationaldayoflistening.org/great-questions-list/>
- Read a children's book. Add sound effects for turning the page.
- Record a Radio Show
- Podcast about a current event
- Expose students to different types of music (culture for social studies)
- Record an audio conference with an "expert"
- Other – approve by instructor first

Grading Criteria for the podcast follows.

### **Grading Criteria**

	<b>Points Possible</b>	<b>Points Earned</b>
Grade Level, subject(s), and standard(s) clearly apply to podcast for instructional purposes	10	
Transcript to read or interview questions are typed <b>OR</b> Children's book is selected to read – bibliographic information is typed	10	
Podcast is recorded clearly with a balance between speakers (if more than one participate) and is a between 1-5 minutes. Necessary edits are made to make the podcast flow smoothly without speaking errors.	12.5	
Background music and other sounds are added to the podcast and do not overpower the speaking voice.	12.5	
Podcast is uploaded to Dropbox and a link is provided on the Garageband Podcast Page	5
