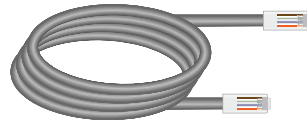

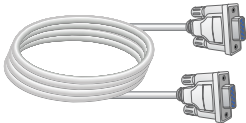

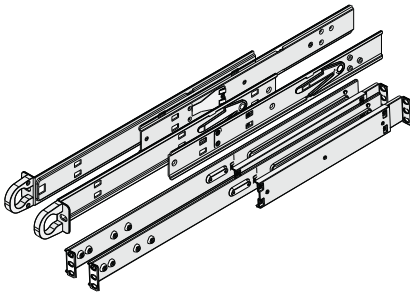

# Installation

The FortiAnalyzer unit can be mounted in any standard 19 inch rack unit with the provided mounting hardware. The FortiAnalyzer can also be installed in an Open Rack.

*Please also read "Cautions and Warnings" on page 12 prior to installing your device.*

**Caution:** The rack must be stabilized before sliding the unit out for servicing. Failure to stabilize may cause the rack to tip over.

Electrostatic discharge (ESD) can damage your Fortinet equipment.

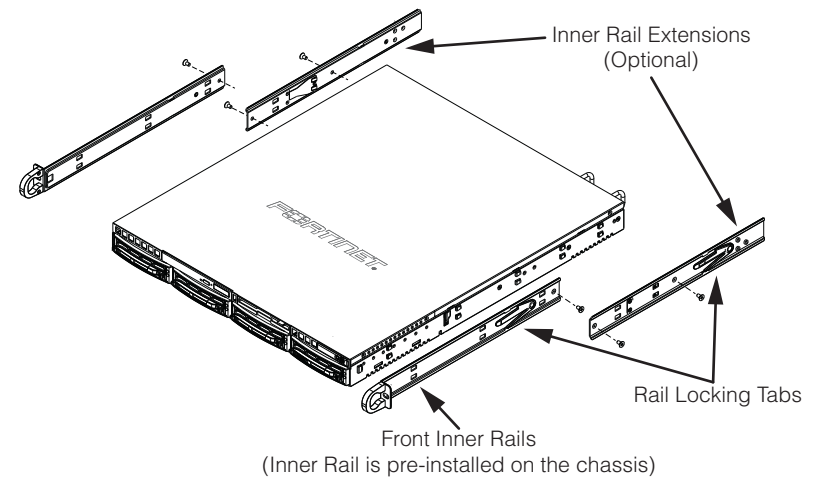
To avoid personal injury or damage to the unit, it is recommended that two or more people install the unit into the rack.

Do not place heavy objects on the unit.

## Rack Precautions

- Ensure the leveling jacks on the bottom of the rack are fully extended to the floor with the full weight of the rack resting on the jacks.
- For single rack installation, stabilizers should be attached to the rack.
- For multiple rack installations, the racks should be coupled together.
- Ensure the rack is stable before extending a component from the rack.
- Only extend one component at a time; extending two or more simultaneously may cause the rack to become unstable.

## Rack Rail Identification



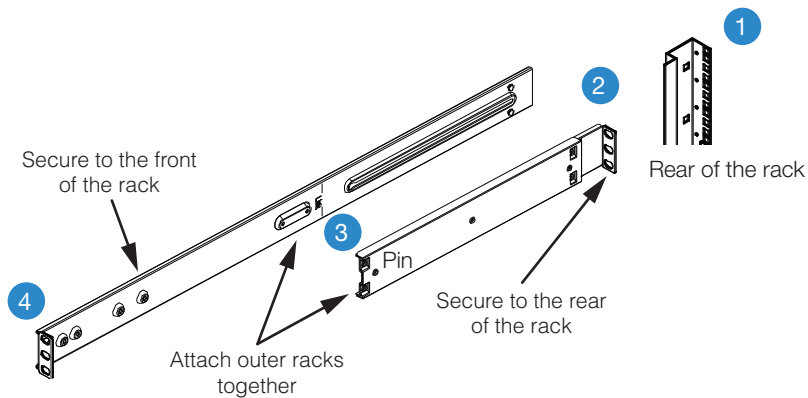
The rail mount kit includes two rail assemblies. Each assembly consists of two sections:

- A fixed inner rail that secures directly to the unit
- A fixed outer rack that secures directly to the rack

Both rail assemblies have locking tabs. The tabs lock the unit into place when installed into the rack and when fully extended from the rack. This prevents the device from sliding fully out of the rack when the device is being worked on.

## Rack Installation

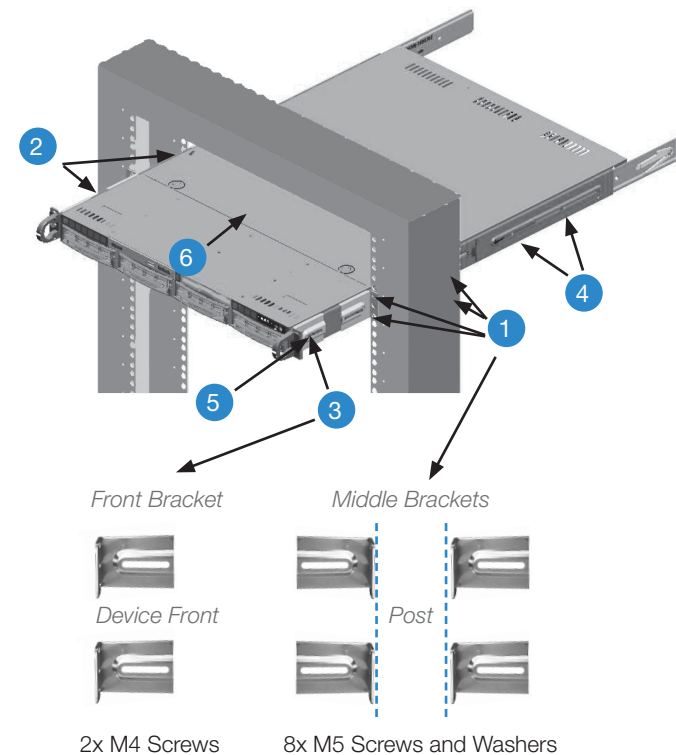
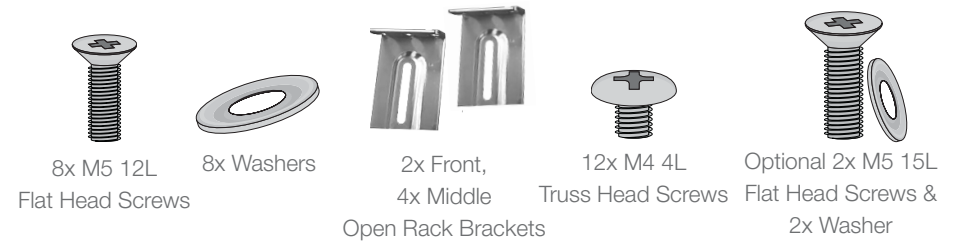
To install the FortiAnalyzer into a standard 19 inch rack, you will need:



1. Put the [rack nuts](#) in the correct positions at the [rear of the rack](#)
2. Secure the [rear outer rail](#) to the [rear of the rack](#) with two screws and washers on each side
3. Align the [front outer rail](#) beside the [rear outer rail](#), ensuring the pin on the rear outer rail is pushed into the round hole of the front outer rail
4. Extend the rail to the [front of the rack](#) and align it to the rack post and screw holes
5. Secure the [front outer rail](#) to the rack post with two screws and washers on each side
6. Option: Secure the [front rail](#) to the [chassis ear](#) using one M5 15L screw and washer on each side
7. Insert the chassis on the outer rails and [slide into the rack](#)

## 2 Post Open Rack Installation

To install the FortiAnalyzer into an open 2 post rack, you will need:



1. Attach the [middle open rack brackets](#) to each post using eight M5 screws and washers
2. Secure the [outer rail](#) to the rail mount brackets using two M4 screws on each side
3. Attach the [front open rack brackets](#) with the [front outer rail](#) using four M4 screws
4. Secure the [inner rail](#) to the [chassis](#) using two M4 screws on each side
5. Option: Secure the [front rail](#) to the [chassis ear](#) using one M5 15L screw and washer on each side
6. Insert the chassis on the outer rails and [slide into the rack](#)

## Cautions and Warnings

### Environmental Specifications

Ambient operating temperature: 0C to 40C

Elevated Operating Ambient - If installed in a closed or multi-unit rack assembly, the operating ambient temperature of the rack environment may be greater than room ambient. Therefore, consideration should be given to installing the equipment in an environment compatible with the maximum ambient temperature (Tma) specified by the manufacturer. Température ambiante élevée - S'il est installé dans un rack fermé ou à unités multiples, la température ambiante de fonctionnement de l'environnement du rack peut être supérieure à la température ambiante de la pièce. Reduced Air Flow - Installation of the equipment in a rack should be such that the amount of air flow required for safe operation of the equipment is not compromised. Ventilation réduite - Installation de l'équipement dans un rack doit être telle que la quantité de flux d'air nécessaire au bon fonctionnement de l'équipement n'est pas compromise.

Mechanical Loading - Mounting of the equipment in the rack should be such that a hazardous condition is not achieved due to uneven mechanical loading. Chargement Mécanique - Montage de l'équipement dans le rack doit être telle qu'une situation dangereuse n'est pas liée à un chargement mécanique inégal.

Circuit Overloading - Consideration should be given to the connection of the equipment to the supply circuit and the effect that overloading of the circuits might have on overcurrent protection and supply wiring. Appropriate consideration of equipment nameplate ratings should be used when addressing this concern.

Reliable Earthing - Reliable earthing of rack-mounted equipment should be maintained. Particular attention should be given to supply connections other than direct connections to the branch circuit (e.g. use of power strips).
