Supported platforms

The EMS server can be installed on any of the following platforms:

- Microsoft Windows Server 2008 R2 or newer

System Requirements

The minimum system requirement is as follows.

- 2.0 GHz 64-bit processor with dual core (or two virtual CPUs)
- 4 GB RAM (8GB RAM is recommended)
- 40 GB free hard disk
- Gigabit (10/100/1000baseT) Ethernet adapter
- Internet access

Internet access is required during installation. This becomes optional once installation is completed. The EMS uses access to the internet to obtain information about FortiGuard engine and signature updates.



You should only install EMS and the default services for the operating system on the server. Additional services should not be installed on the same server as EMS.

Endpoint Requirements

The following FortiClient platforms are supported:

- FortiClient for Microsoft Windows
- FortiClient for Mac OS X

The FortiClient version should be 5.4.1 or newer.

FortiClient is supported on multiple Microsoft Windows and Mac OS X platforms. The EMS supports all such platforms as endpoints.

Upgrade

Upgrading from previous EMS versions

FortiClient EMS 1.0.5 supports upgrading from EMS 1.0.4 and older.

Downgrading to previous versions

Downgrading FortiClient EMS 1.0.5 to previous EMS versions is not supported.

Resolved Issues

The following issues have been fixed in version 1.0.5.

Bug ID	Description
411780	Full KA Timeout does not work until the FCM Server is restarted.
412036	Cannot view certificate details.
405687	Unable to save settings using Firefox.
410781	The T-SQL does not work as expected after installing EMS.
412014	Upgrading from 1.0.3 to 1.0.4 may fail.
405466	Users can still access EMS remotely using the previous defined custom host name even after making the field blank.
377374	T-SQL Execution CMD exception occurs during EMS installation.
380893	Unable to install EMS 1.0.0 or 1.0.1 0x080070643, a <i>Fatal Error During Install</i> error is returned.
413275	Cannot uninstall EMS via control panel.
414434	Cannot restore DB backup files

Bug ID	Description
383635	Fcmaddaemon INSERT may not work as expected.
404629	EMS displays domain machines when you click <i>Endpoints</i> , but not under a domain.
405421	SSL certificate date is displayed as <i>invalid</i> in browsers.
407401	AD domain only partially populating EMS.
409588	Web Filter compliance does not work as expected.
409742	The search bar does not filter records when there is no match.
410030	Connection does not work with fgd1.fortigate.com.
410377	The filter does not work when there is no match to the filter content.
412348	EMS 1.0.4 is not receiving the full AD structure.
413250	EMS does not report errors when creating an installer does not work.
413273	EMS failed to synced with the Domain controller.
413482	EMS uninstalled FortiClient when trying to upgrade.
413618	EMS reported incorrect install information.
413717	EMS does not alert the user to delete login.
413868	User is not removed from the old LDAP server after switching the LDAP server.
439099	EMS 1.0.5 should not allow creation of the FortiClient 5.6.0 installer.



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
