Licensing

Licensing on the FortiGate is based on the number of registered clients. FortiGate 30 series and higher models support ten (10) free managed FortiClient licenses. For additional managed clients, a FortiClient license subscription must be purchased. The maximum number of managed clients varies per device model.

Client limits

The following table shows client limits per FortiGate model series.

FortiGate/FortiWiFi 30 to 90 series	10	1 year FortiClient license subscription for up to 200 clients
FortiGate 100 to 300 series	10	1 year FortiClient license subscription for up to 600 clients
FortiGate 500 to 800 series, FortiGate vM01, FortiGate VM02	10	1 year FortiClient license subscription for up to 2000 clients
FortiGate 1000 series, FortiGate VM04	10	1 year FortiClient license subscription for up to 8000 clients
FortiGate 3000 to 5000 series, FortiGate VM08	10	1 year FortiClient license subscription for up to 20 000 clients



In high availability (HA) configurations, all cluster members require an upgrade license key.

Installation Information

Firmware images and tools

When installing FortiClient version 5.2.6, you can choose the setup type that best suits your needs. You can select one of the two options:

- Complete: all Endpoint Security and VPN components will be installed.
- VPN Only: only VPN components (IPsec and SSL) will be installed.

FortiClient includes various tools to help with and customize installations. The following tools and files are available in the *FortiClientTools* file:

- *OnlineInstaller*: downloads and installs the latest FortiClient file from the public FortiGuard Distribution Server (FDS).
- *FortiClientConfigurator*: an installer repackaging tool that can be used to create custom installation packages
- *RebrandingResources*: resources used by the FortiClient Configurator tool for rebranding.



When creating a custom FortiClient 5.2.6 installer using the FortiClient Configurator tool, you can choose which features to install. You can also enable or disable software updates, configure SSO, and rebrand FortiClient .

Upgrade from a previous version

FortiClient version 5.2.6 supports upgrade from FortiClient version 5.0.9 and later.

Downgrade to previous versions

Downgrading FortiClient version 5.2.6 to previous FortiClient versions is not supported.

Uninstall FortiClient

To uninstall FortiClient version 5.2.6, use the *Application > FortiClient > Uninstaller* application.

Firmware image checksums

After logging in, click on *Download > Firmware Image Checksums*, enter the image file name including the extension, and select *Get Checksum Code*.
