302902	IPSec does not use Android OS CA to verify the server certificate.

Bug ID	Description
211809	FortiClient may not automatically prompt and register over an IPsec VPN connection.
221980	FortiClient may not display the FortiToken dialog when the FortiGate configuration has the user configured in the SSL VPN firewall policy.
246498	Elliptical curve certificates may not be supported.
297947	FortiClient may not be able to use imported certificates.
447697	IPSec fails to connect if using any DH group other than 5.
