4. Download the latest zip file:

Set ADOM mode to Normal and set Operation Mode to Standalone. Ensure that workspace-mode is disabled.</p>
FortiAnalyzer	<p>FortiMoM supports FortiAnalyzer v5.2.0.</p>

Defect ID	Description
0277494	When FortiManager has the Valid Basic VM license (10 devices), you can add only 5 domains to a Cascade group
0278244	If you change the name of an address group that is included in one or more policy rules, the address group is no longer displayed properly
0279360	Cannot change NAT status in any package rule. When you select a new option from the right-click menu, the system indicates operation success, but the NAT value does not change.
0280227	Search function does not work in any of the Object lists
0280255	Policy rule enable and disable has no effect (from the menu when you right-click a policy rule seq #)
0280282	With Firefox browser, no objects can be deleted from the policy pkg table
0285999	Pending task list may show a pending task even when no task is being executed.
0285820	In the completed tasks list, the system displays the wrong number of ADOMs added for each connection.
0280542	When you edit a domain and set Select All Devices/Groups or Specify Devices/Groups, this value is not saved.
0280674	When you edit a backup domain, the system automatically adds one more [Backup] to the domain name.
0280004	System allows users to create more than one object with the same name. The original and duplicate objects will both appear on policy rule
0283661	With Safari browser, when you right-click columns in a policy rule, the right-click menu does not display properly, and objects cannot be removed from the policy.
0283654	With Safari browser, you cannot edit or delete objects in the objects list.
0283657	With Safari browser, when you create a group, the group main panel does not display properly
0280959*	When importing FortiManager data (FMG-v5.2.1 or FMG-v5.2.2) into the FortiMoM, FortiMoM will display extra objects (Interface, Services, Security Profiles) that are usually hidden in the FortiManager views.
0282520	You cannot migrate an ADOM if any FortiGate units in that ADOM are operating in HA mode.



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
