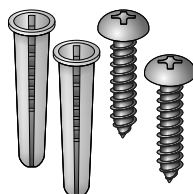

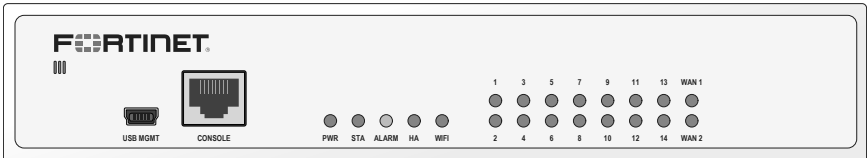

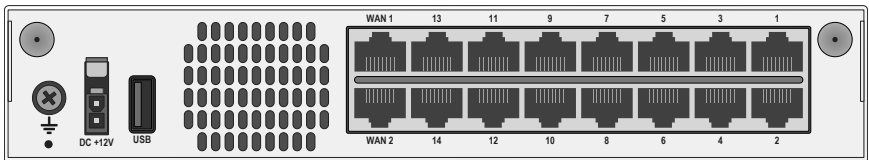

Professional Installation Instruction

1. Installation personnel
This product is designed for specific application and needs to be installed by qualified personnel who has RF and related rule knowledge. The general user shall not attempt to install or change the settings.
2. Installation location
The product shall be installed at a location where the radiating antenna can be kept 20cm from nearby person in normal operation condition to meet Regulatory RF exposure requirement. The installation applies to both indoor and outdoor location.
3. External antenna(s)
