Claim: A statement of what you understand or a conclusion that you have reached from an investigation or set of investigations.	/2
Evidence: Data collected during investigations and trends in that data (clearly labeled data table and/or graph).	/4
Science Knowledge: Knowledge about how things work. You may have learned this through reading, talking to an expert, discussion, or other experiences. (This will most likely come to your textbook.)	/4
Explanation: At least one paragraph combining your Claim, Evidence, and Science Knowledge. Using what you've learned in Language Arts, your Claim is your "yellow" and your Evidence and Science Knowledge is your "red." (You don't have a "green" since this isn't an essay.)
