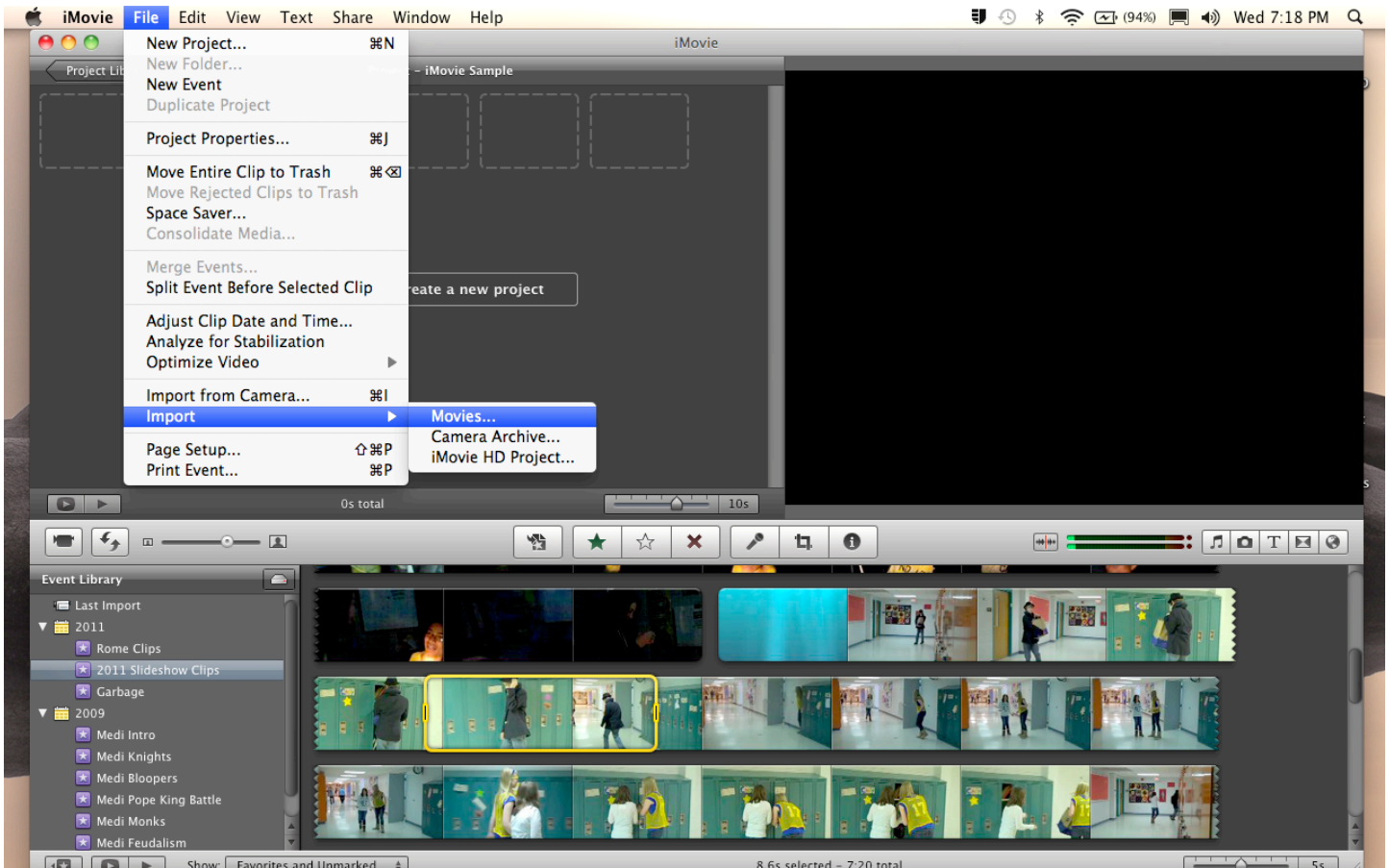


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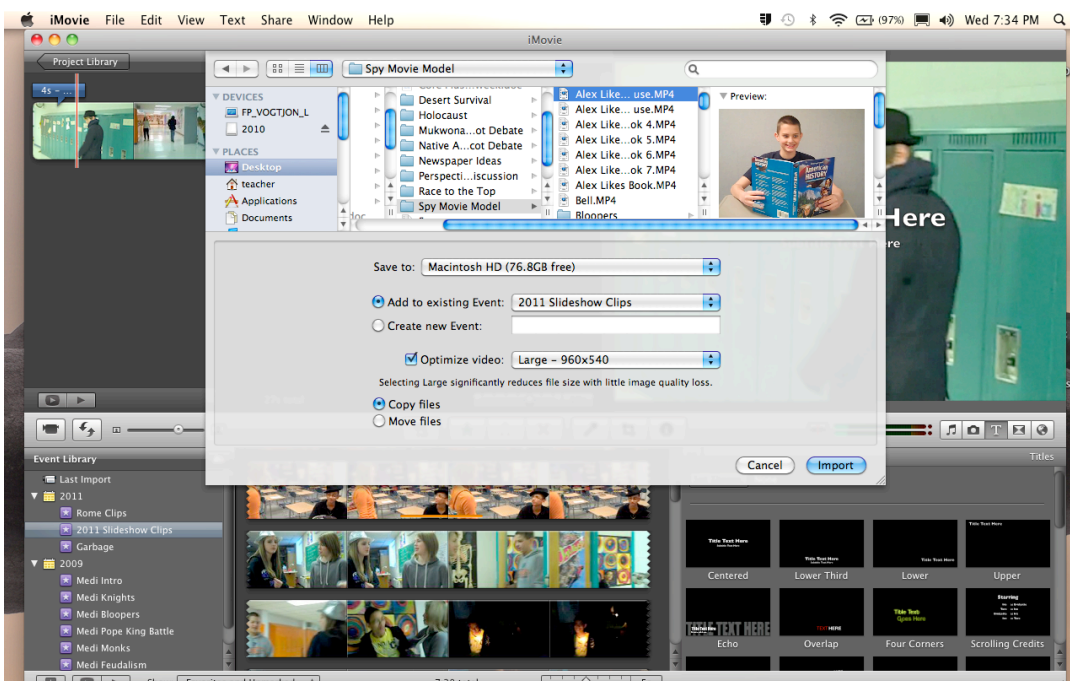
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1. Add a movie clip to iMovie

Step 1: Go to: File—Import—Movies

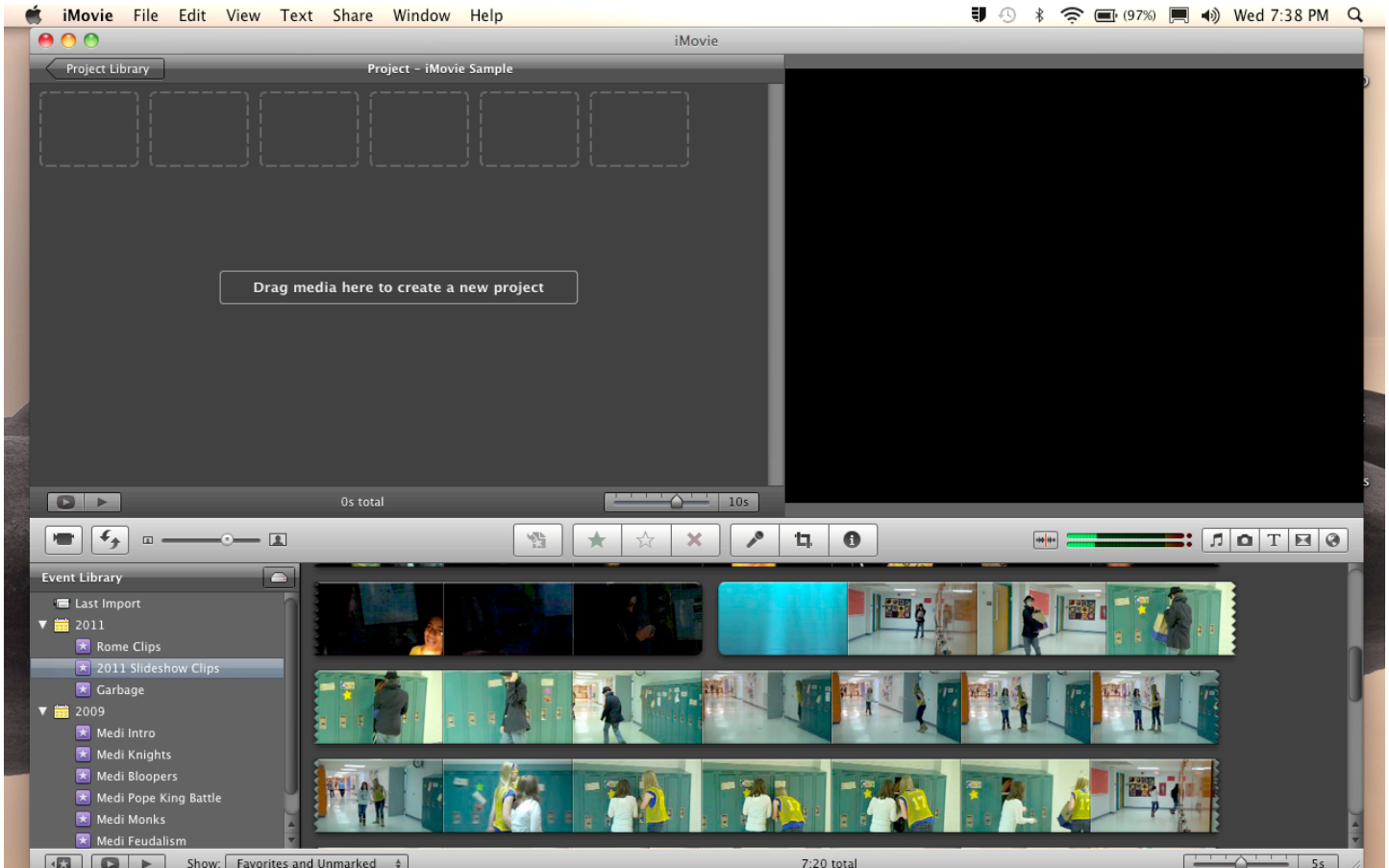


Step 2: find the movie clip you want to edit, click “import”

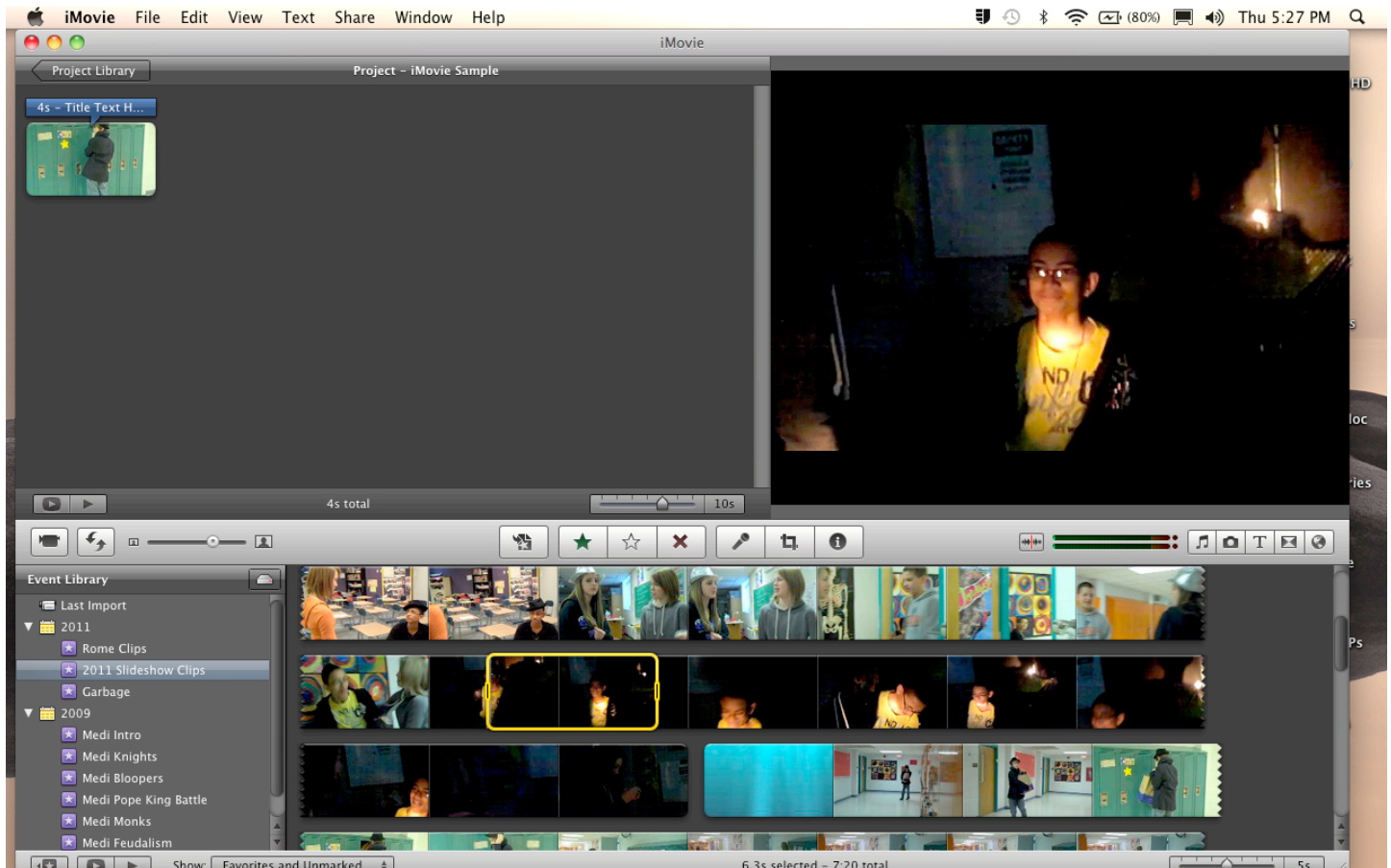


2. Add a video clip to the timeline

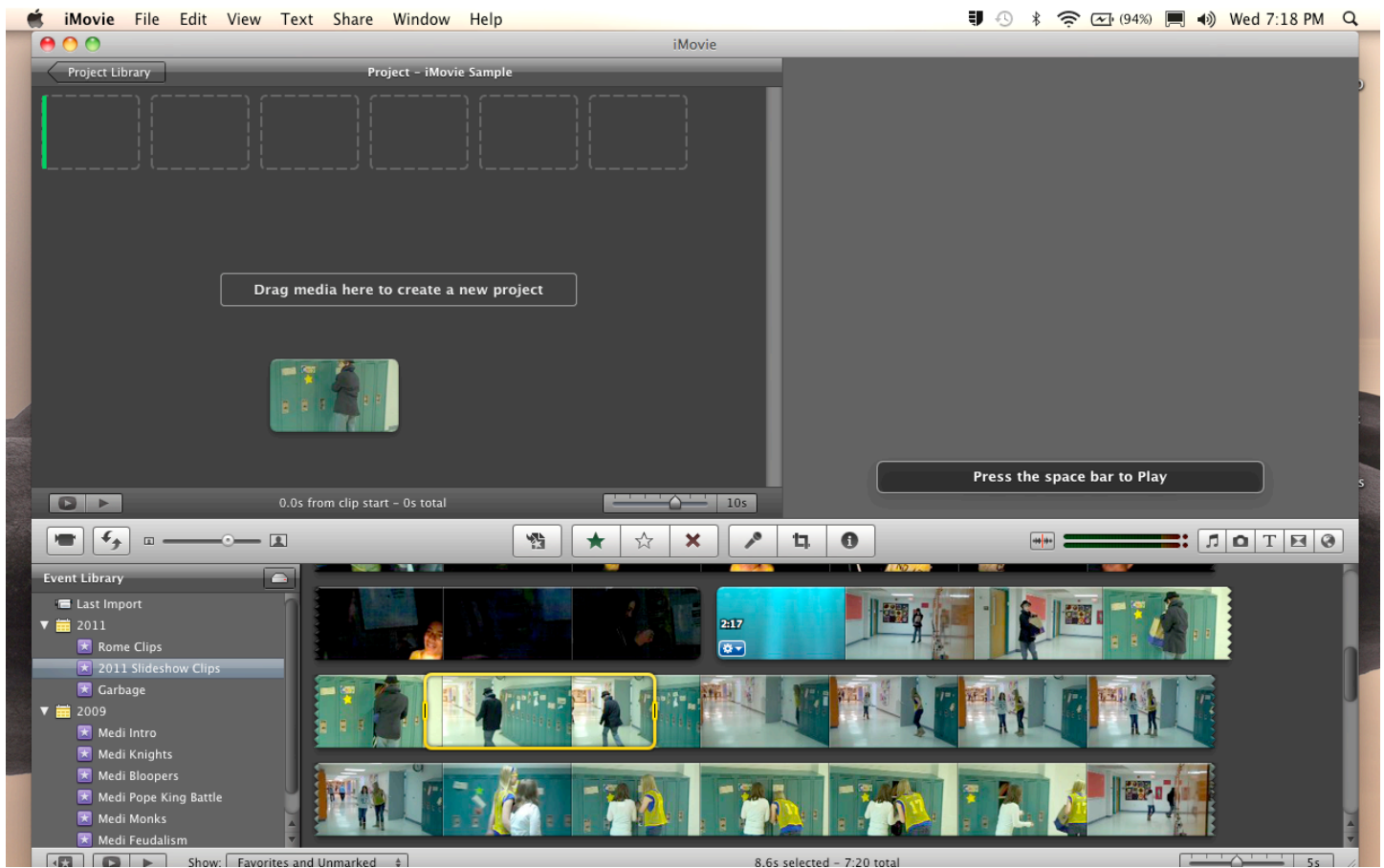
Step 1: find all of your uploaded clips by looking in the lower portion of your screen



Step 2: select video by clicking on the clip and dragging the yellow bars to cover the portion you want to edit



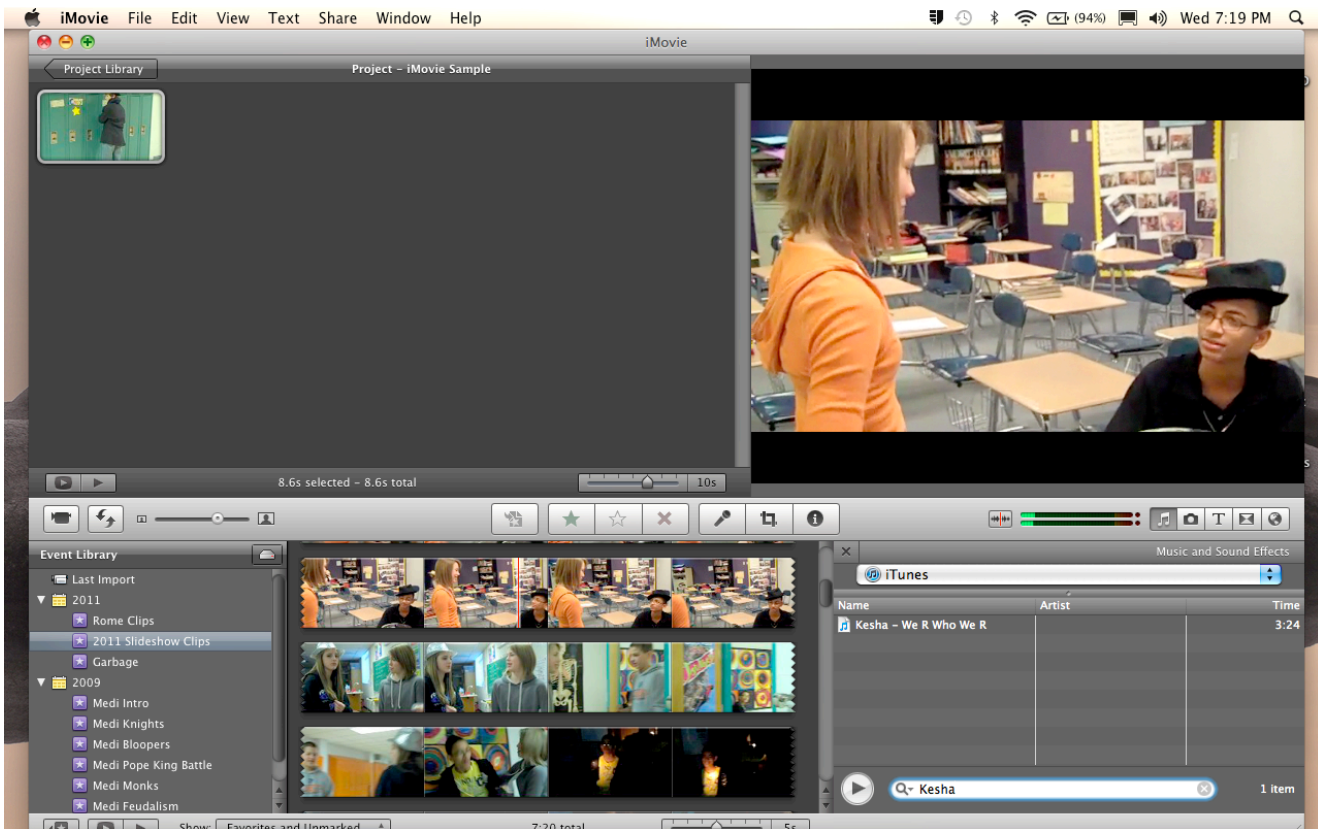
Step 3: click and drag the portion between the yellow bars to the timeline (upper left hand portion of the screen)



3. Add music to video clip

Step 1: Import the song into iTunes (remember, you can only use 10% of the song, with a maximum of 30 seconds. Ex, 4 min song = 240 seconds, $240 \times .10 = 24$ seconds)

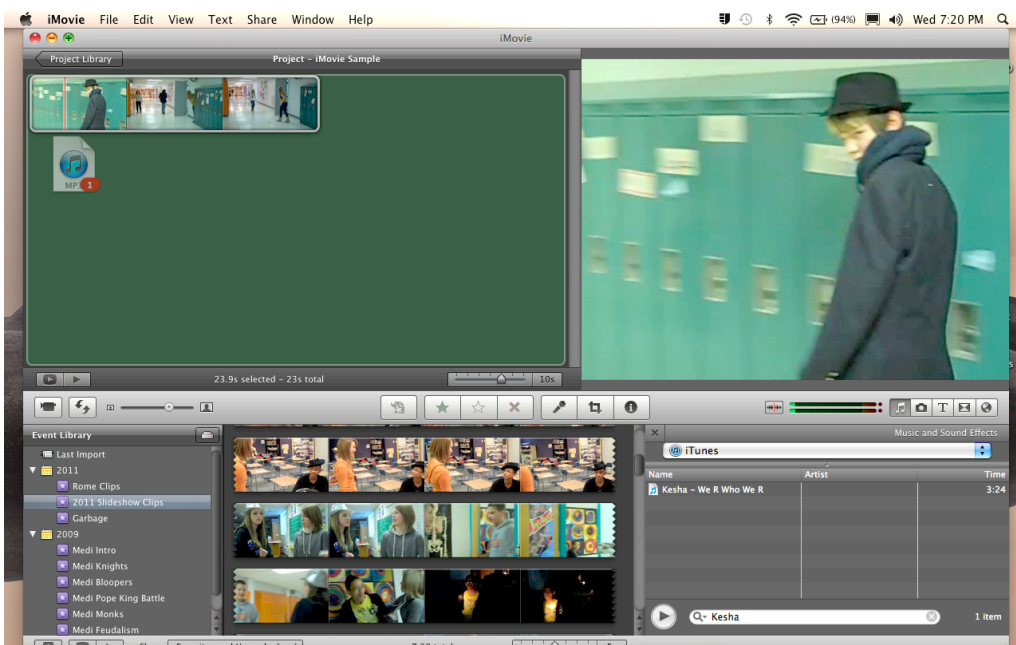
Step 2: Click on the music button(lower right hand portion of screen), type in the artist name in the search box



Step 3: Click and drag the song into the timeline, bring it directly to the clip you want



Note on music: Do not drag the clip to cover the entire project. If you do, the entire timeline will turn green(see below). You do not want this option because you will not only be stuck with the same song the entire video but you will violate copyright law. If the timeline turns green, keep holding the mouse click down and move it around to get rid of the green. (see above for how adding music should look)

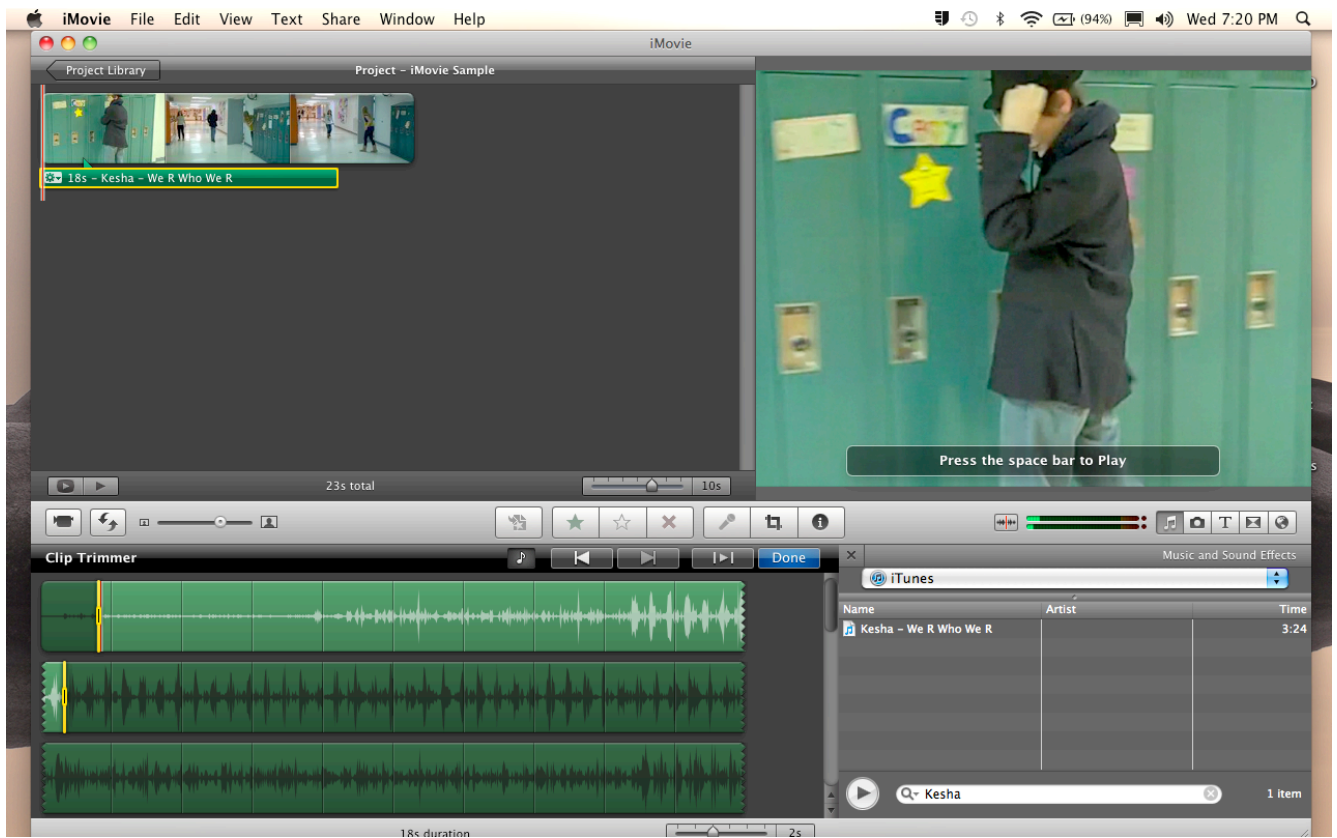


4. Select a portion of an audio clip (so you don't use the entire audio clip)

Step 1: Open the "Clip Trimmer"



Step 2: Drag the yellow bars to find the portion of the audio clip you want. Click “DONE” when finished.



5. Add a transition between video clips

Step 1: click on the transition button in the lower right hand corner

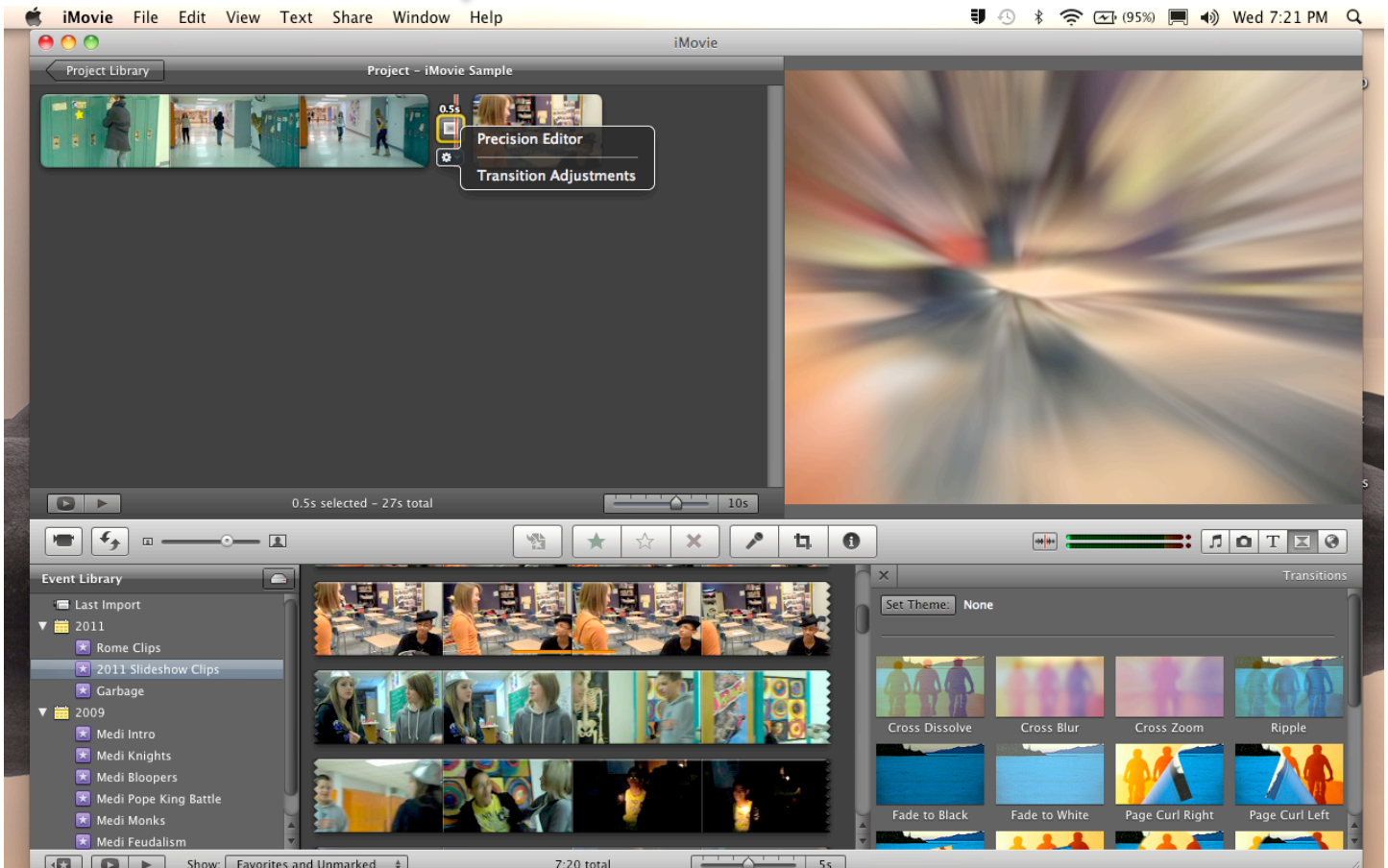


Step 2: Drag the transition to the area between two video clips in your timeline



6. Change the duration of a transition

Step 1: click on the lower portion of the transition, choose “Transition Adjustments”



7. Add titles to the project

Step 1: select "T" for title on the right hand side of the screen



Step 2: drag the type of title you would like over the video in the timeline



8. Edit title

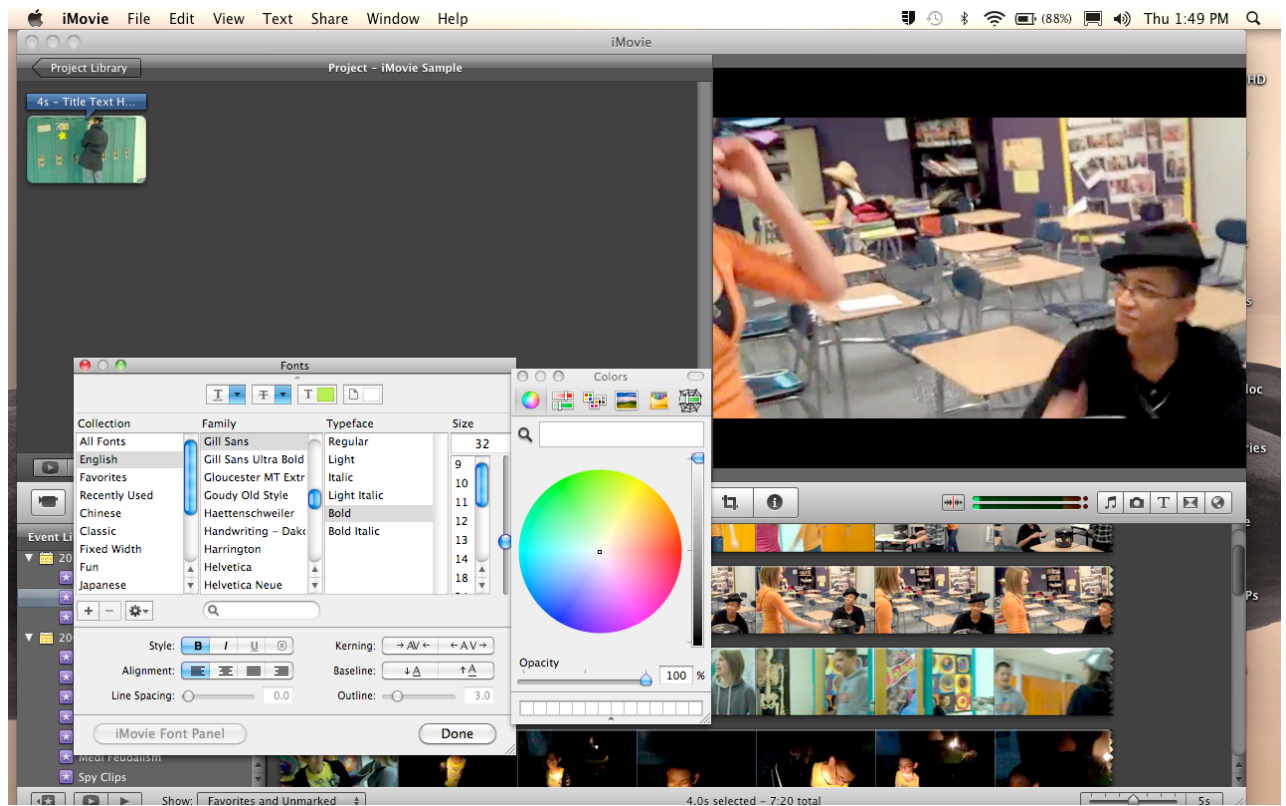
Step 1: Click on the title above the video clip in the timeline, click on the text area on the right hand side of the screen



Step 2: Choose: Text—Show Fonts



Step 3: Edit the color, font style and size of text

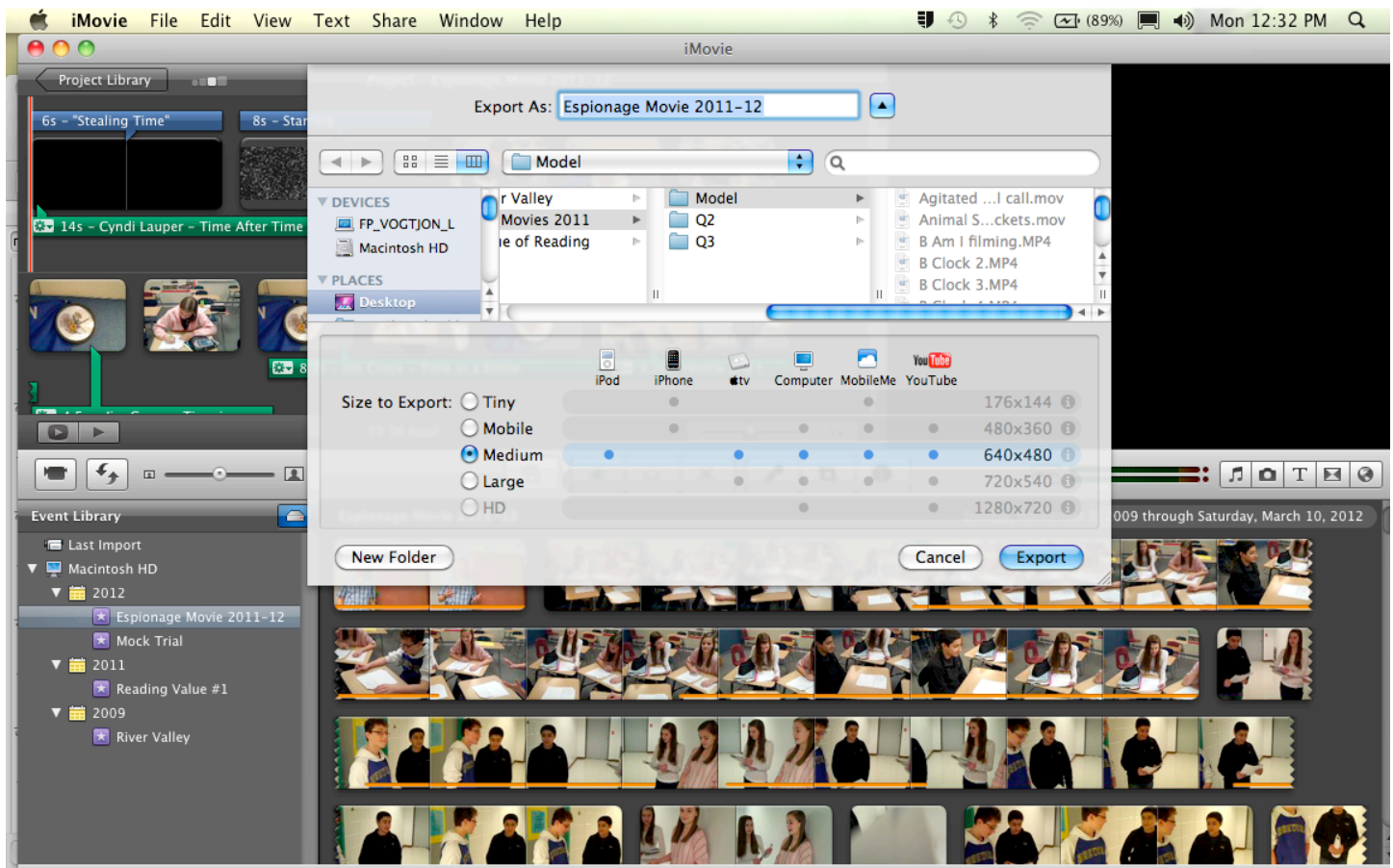


9. Exporting

Step 1: Click “Share” and “Export”



Step 2: Make sure “Medium” is checked, make sure your student folder is the export destination



Step 3: Click “Export”
