1. Open OPAC from Library Links and go to your school.

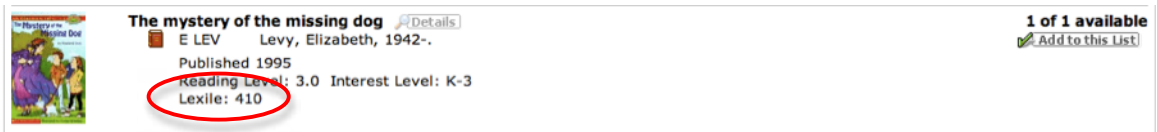

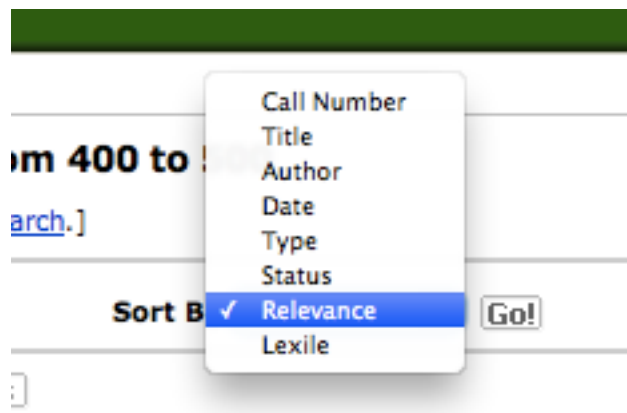

4. Looking at each entry - you see the title, author, call number and lexile listed. The far right lists availability of the book.



5. You can sort the list of results if you like. Click on the drop down in the middle where it says Sort By. Sorting by call number will group all non-fiction together, all Everybody books together and all Chapter books together in the list. Select the method you want to use to sort and click Go.



6. If your search isn't quite what you need, you can click on the **Refine Your Search** in blue and go back to the main screen and make adjustments to your search or limiters. Or you can start all over by clicking on **Library Search** under the Home Tab.
