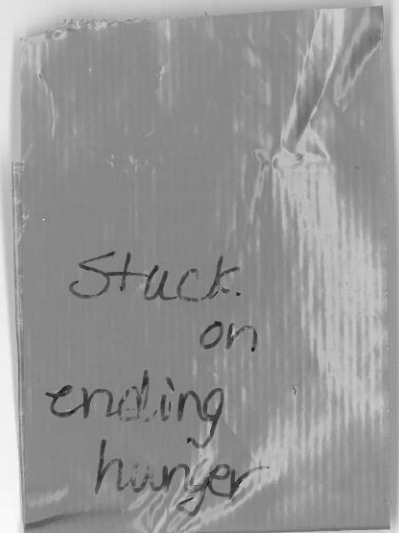


SCHOOL LAUNCHES FOOD DRIVE
