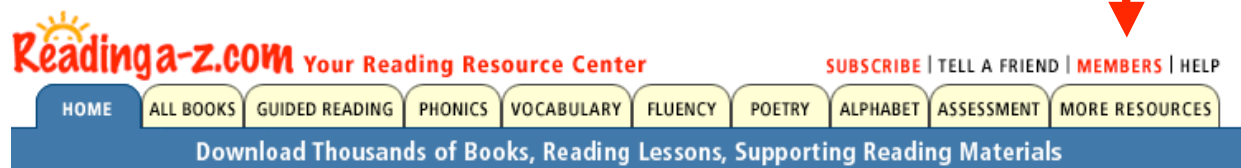


Reading A-Z
