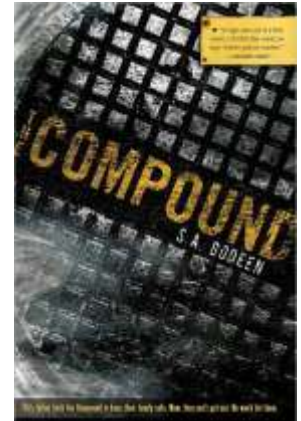

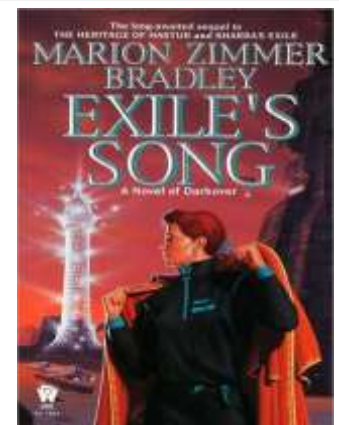

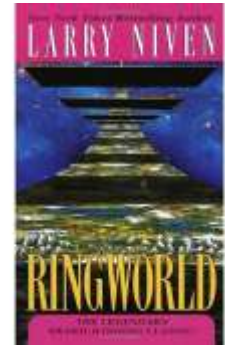

Author Larry Niven

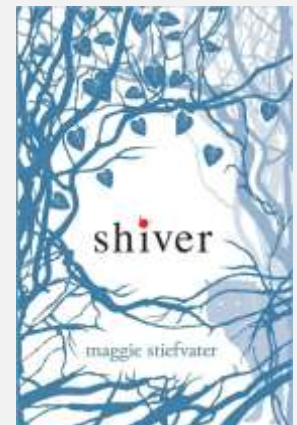
