WHAT IS BELLWORK

Everyday there will be a very short prompt that you will need to complete as soon as you take your seat.

HOMEWORK/ CLASSWORK

All work is to be done by YOU, not your friends, neighbors, or anyone else. You can work with others if you have questions, as long as you are completing your own work. Try to think of homework and class work as practice with the end result of being prepared for quizzes and unit tests. I do not accept assignments. All assignments will be posted on the board in front of classroom and usually posted on class web site. You are responsible for writing down assignment from the board as I may not be able to post homework online every day.

LABORATORY'S

Think of laboratories as the actual physical “doing” of the chemistry we talk about. They are hands on and require you to complete some work before and after the lab. This may include limited research or calculating before and after a lab.

PROJECT

We will do a research style project first semester to help prepare you for conducting your *science fair project* which will be due second semester. More details will be given during the school year.

UNIT TESTS

They will cover the major points of the unit you are finishing up and because chemistry is sequential they will cover essential previous material. Most tests will be at the end of units. I also may give pop quizzes.

FINAL EXAM

Yes you will have a final exam, but don't worry about it right now, as long as you stay on top of the unit objectives and keep up with the class and all of your work you will be more than prepared for the exam.

WHERE TO GET HELP

The sooner and more frequently you ask for assistance the better off you will be. You will have a hard time in chemistry if you wait until the last minute to get assistance. If you are unsure about a topic ask immediately during study tables. Try to make it a goal to come in one (1) time a week for at least fifteen (15) minutes. Use on line tutorials and help sites.

Excused absences only

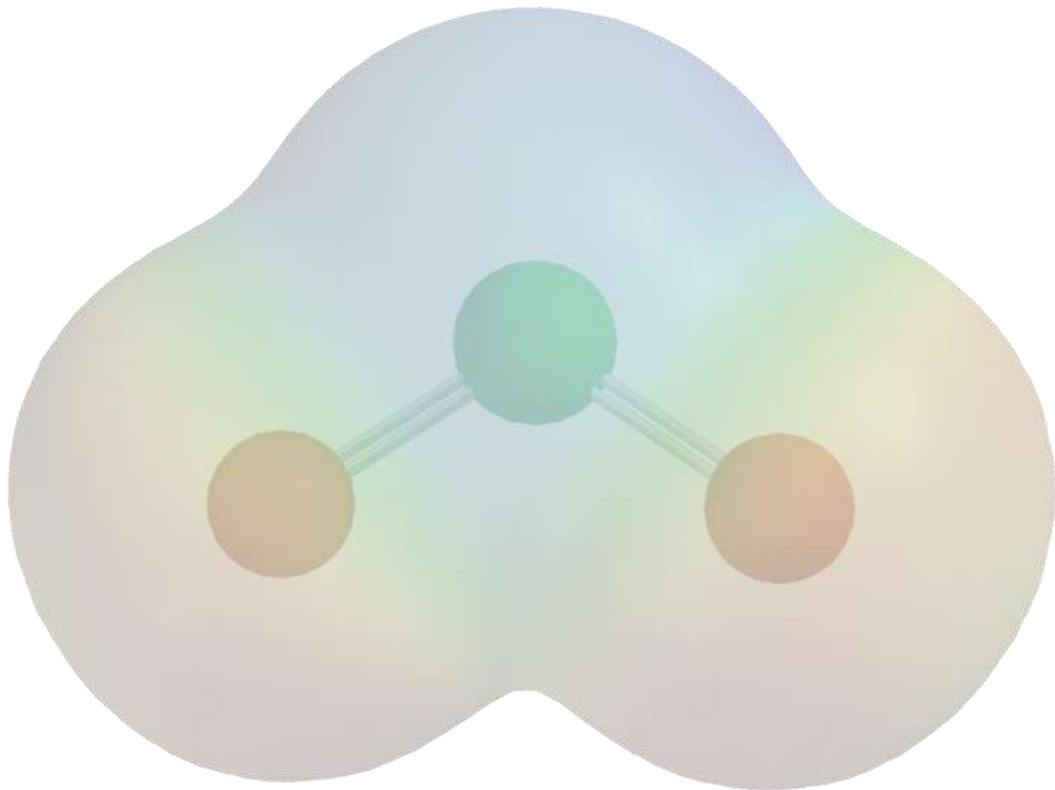
