HOMEWORK/ CLASSWORK

All work is to be done by **you**, not your friends, neighbors, or anyone else. You can work with others if you have questions, as long as you are completing your own work. Try to think of homework and class work as practice with the end result of being prepared for quizzes and unit tests. **I do not accept late assignments.** All assignments will be posted on the board in front of

classroom and *usually* posted on class website. You are responsible for writing down assignments from the board as.

We will cover concept quickly in class and spend time on the major objectives.

LABORATORIES

Think of laboratories as the actual physical “doing” of the chemistry we talk about. They are hands on and require you to complete some work before and after the lab. This may include limited research or calculating before and after a lab. Exams will include concepts and techniques from labs and may even be lab practical’s.

PROJECT/ SCIENCE FAIR

We will do a research project first semester commonly known as *science fair*. You will complete a written report semester I and then turn that into a poster for the school science fair. Second semester we will complete another project. More details will be given during the school year.

TESTS

These will cover the major points of the unit you are finishing up and because chemistry is sequential they will cover essential previous material. Most tests will be at the end of units. Additionally you will have intermittent quizzes. Most tests and quizzes will be short free-response questions.

FINAL EXAM

Yes you will have a final exam, but don’t worry about it right now, as long as you stay on top of the unit objectives and keep up with the class and all of your work you will be more than prepared for the exam.

Where to Get Help

The sooner and more frequently you ask for assistance the better off you will be. You will have a hard time in chemistry if you wait until the last minute to get assistance. If you are unsure about a topic ask immediately during study tables. Try to make it a goal to come in one (1) time a week for at least fifteen (15) minutes. Use online tutorials and help sites. Form a study group!

Excused absences only

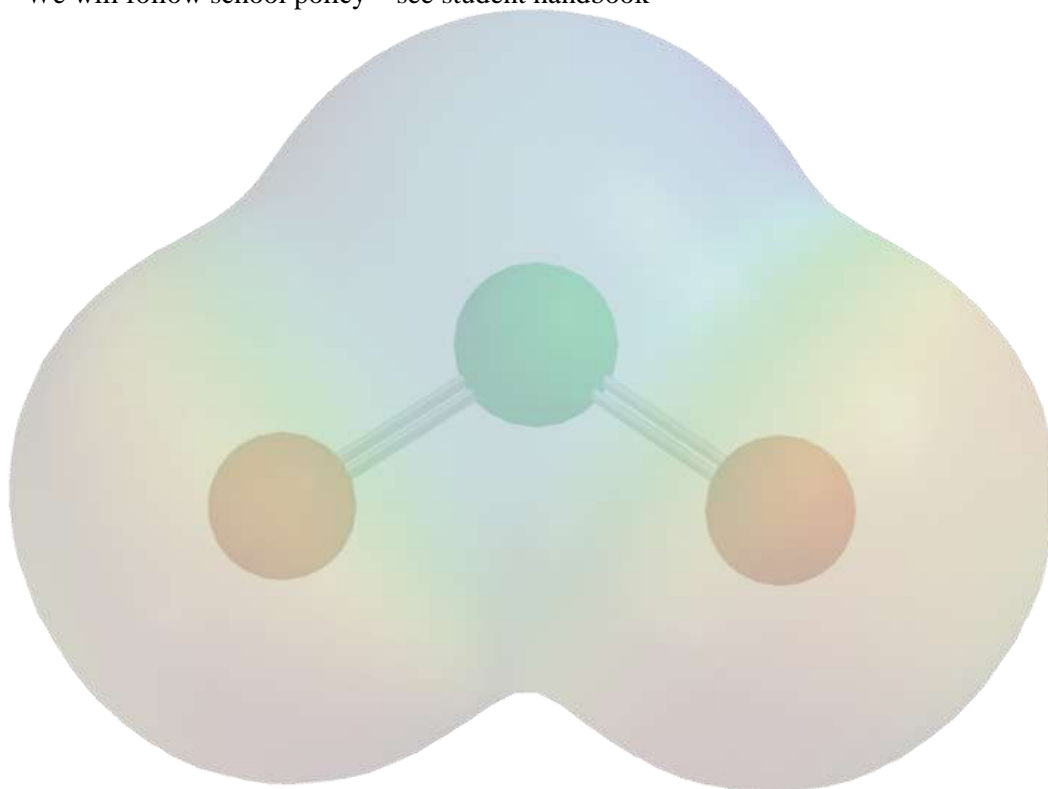
