

## Q&A from Planning Session

*Is there technology available?*

Yes. We will distribute a chart for you to complete indicating all of your technology and material needs. Projectors and extension cords are provided for each breakout and plenary session. Additional technology, such as SMARTboards, netbooks, calculators may be available upon request.

*Who is responsible for getting necessary materials?*

This is part of the information gathered on the list mentioned above. We will provide sticky notes, tape, markers. Others materials will need to be requested.

*Can we know what the composition of our group is before hand? When?*

Yes, we will let you know who is in your breakout group specifically a couple of weeks ahead of CAMPPP. This will include their name, school board, and role.

*How big are the breakout groups?*

The groups are capped at 30. Breakouts will most likely be smaller than that – and perhaps considerably smaller for intermediate/secondary groups.

*Do the plenary presenters have an idea of the samples they might use? Will there be samples they know they will not use?*

The plenary speakers are reviewing the materials now and will be making questions/student responses available to breakout presenters by the end of June.

*What are the work sample collection processes and protocols?*

There are permission forms posted on the wiki to be used when collecting samples and artefacts for use at CAMPPP.

*Is it possible to contact participants before CAMPPP?*

A bulk email will be sent out late July (likely July 27<sup>th</sup>) and information for breakout sessions can be included in this message.

*Would it be possible to have teachers bring some of their private student work for use during breakouts (private use/sharing)?*
