

Cookie recipe given for 6 dozen cookies - see below

How much of each ingredient do you need for 15 dozen cookies?  
Draw pictures to show how you would represent the amounts you need.

Cookie Recipe - Ingredients for 6 Dozen Cookies

- $\frac{1}{4}$  cup butter .75 = 1.875
- $\frac{1}{2}$  cup sugar 0.5 = 1.25
- 2 eggs 2 = 5
- $\frac{1}{2}$  cup cream 0.5 = 1.25
- 1 tsp vanilla 1 = 2.5
- 1 cup flour 1 = 2.5
- 3 cups oatmeal 3 = 7.5
- 2 tsp baking powder 2 = 5
- 1 tsp salt 1 = 2.5
- 1 tsp cinnamon 1 = 2.5
- 1 cup chocolate chips 1 = 2.5

I divided 15 by 6 to find out how much I had to add to the amount of ingredients, then I multiplied that amount by all the ingredients.

$$15 \div 6 = 2.5$$
