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Our goal is to help each child to achieve a superior academic education, a reasoned understanding and acceptance of himself, and the willingness, maturity and self-discipline to manage his own learning.

In this school we will try to help children learn, without pressure or coercion at the pace most appropriate for each child. Much of the instruction is individual and we encourage each child to become ready to take the responsibility for his own education.

The Galloway School will make extensive use of team teaching, programmed instruction, flexible grouping, and other administrative devices to facilitate the individual learning process.

We make these commitments to each child:

1. To respect and deal with him as an individual.
2. To tell him the truth, and expect the truth of him.
3. To seek out and make available the best learning materials, and to design new materials where those available are inadequate.
4. To give him leadership, encouragement, and supervision in the conduct of his education.
5. To seek out and employ talented and intelligent teachers who accept these commitments, and to help those teachers keep well-informed and free to teach.
6. To show him, as clearly as we can, what it is that he will need to in order to have a solid basis education.
7. To give him every chance to use his own initiative and responsibility.
