

RSS- Is a family of web feed. Used to publish frequently updated works. Blogs entries, news headlines, audio, and video.

RSS Reader- A news aggregation website where headlines are collected manually by the website owner.

Widget - is a placeholder name for an object or, more specifically, a mechanical or other manufactured device.

Web 2.0- associated with web applications that facilitate interactive information sharing, interoperability, user-centered design, and collaboration on the World Wide Web.

Cloud Computing - is Internet-based computing, whereby shared resources, software and information are provided to computers and other devices on-demand, like electricity.
