

What is a computer program? instructions that directs the computer to perform tasks

What is the difference between low level and high level language? low level languages are machine-dependent. high level languages are often machine independent.

Define:

Machine Language:it is the only language a computer understands and it uses ones and zeros

Assembly:symbolic instruction codes

Source Program:contains code that will be converted to machine language

Procedural language (3GL):programmer writes instructions a computer how to accomplish a task

DHTML:allows developers to include more graphical interest

XHTML:allows web site to be displayed easily on micro browsers

XML:allow developers to create customized tags

WML:allow developers to create pages for micro browsers

Ajax:method of creating interactive web applications designed to provide immediate response
