

[ABC Splash](#) history, videos, science archives to use. Levels for all classrooms





[Face Talk:](#) get a portrait photo (e.g. [Lincoln](#)) and have it talk for you. A novel way do oral presentations.- 99c




[simplemind+:](#) Mindmapping software. That's simple to use. (Free)

'How to get to Teacher drive and where to find things.



1. Click on the Glasshouse icon on your dock
2. Select the volume you want to mount. Any will do you will see them all



3. scroll down to Teacher if you prefer.
4. Now when you open the finder window you will find the folders on the drive. select teacher.



5. If you use a folder regularly you may want to drag it across into the left hand sidebar. e.g. Drag primary correct into the side bar. You are not moving the folder just putting a link in your sidebar.
