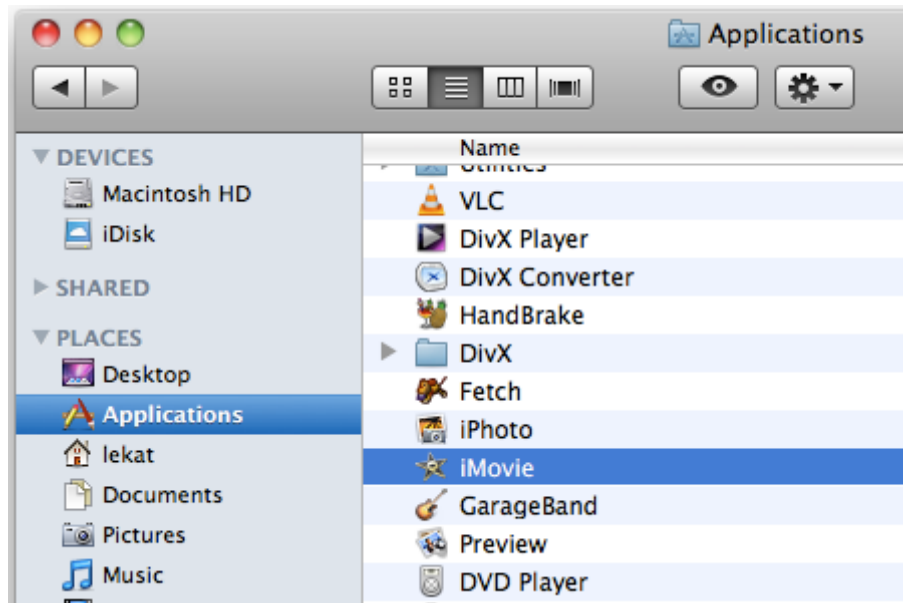
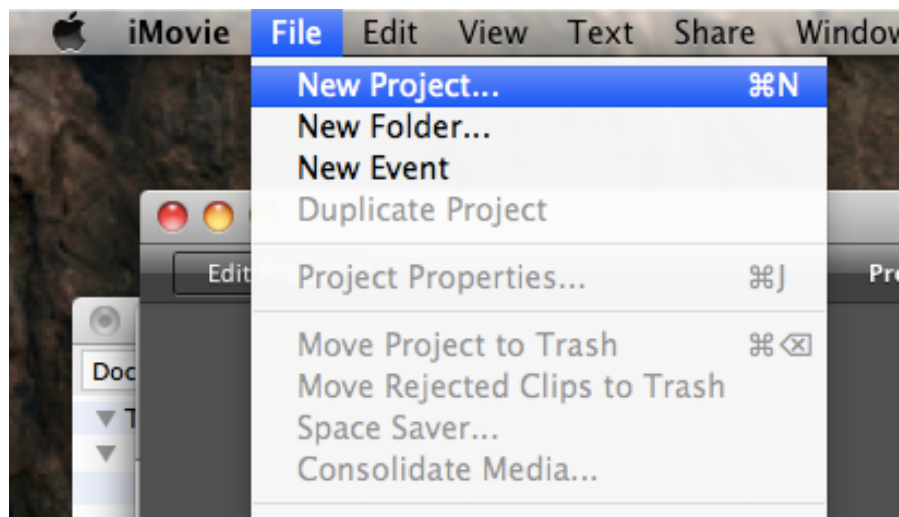


Bringing your Images into iMovie and Exporting a Movie

Open iMovie from the applications folder or dock



From the File Menu, select New Project

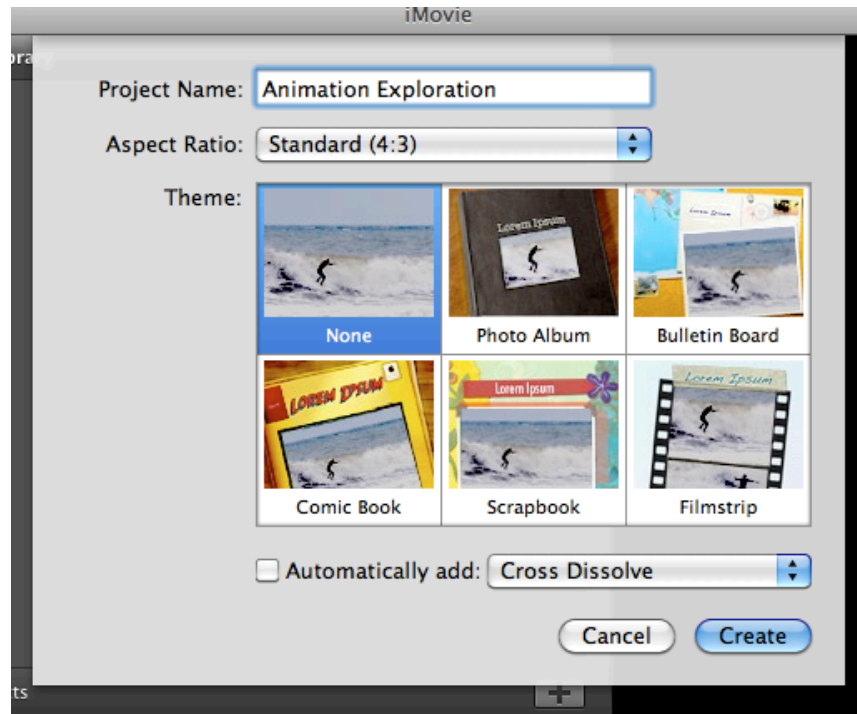


Name your project

members' names.

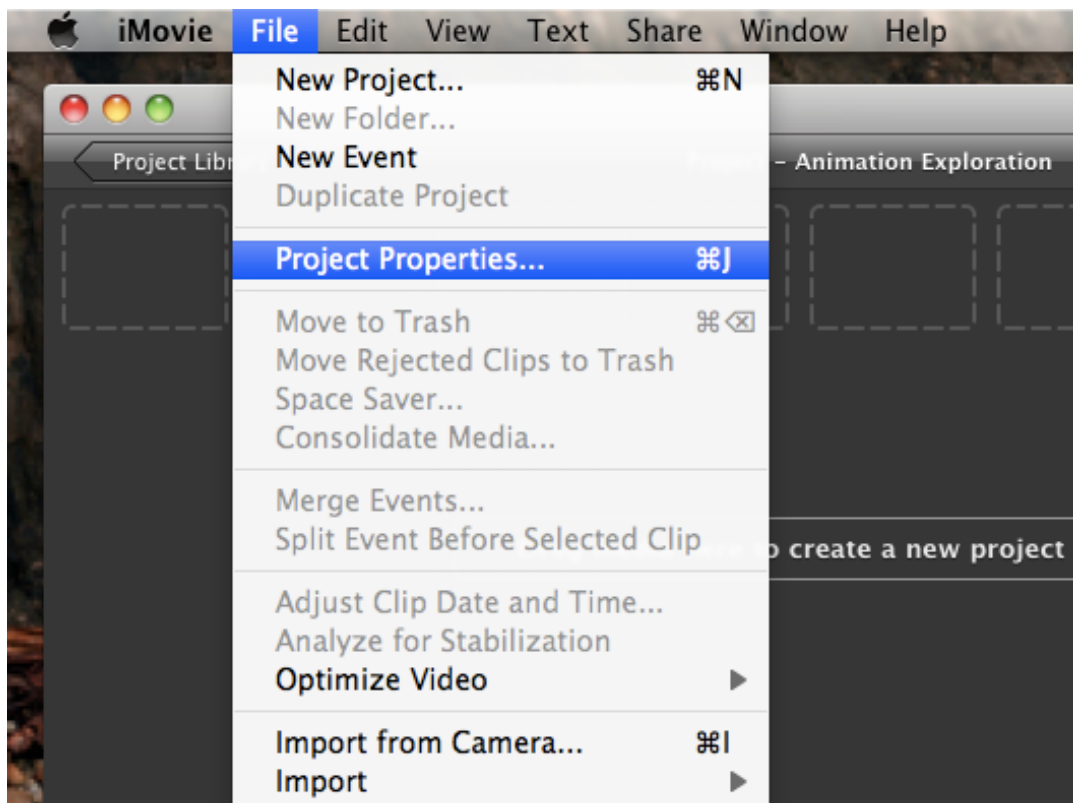
Select the
Standard (4:3)
Aspect Ratio.

Leave the box
unchecked.

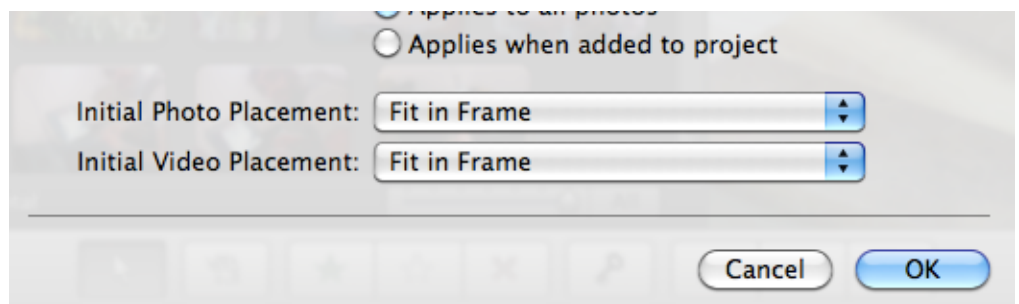
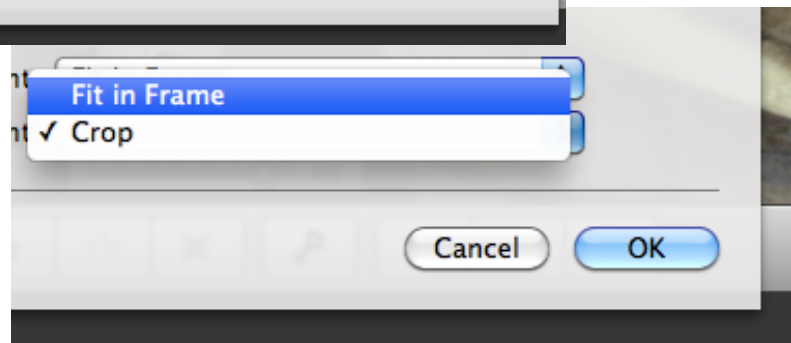
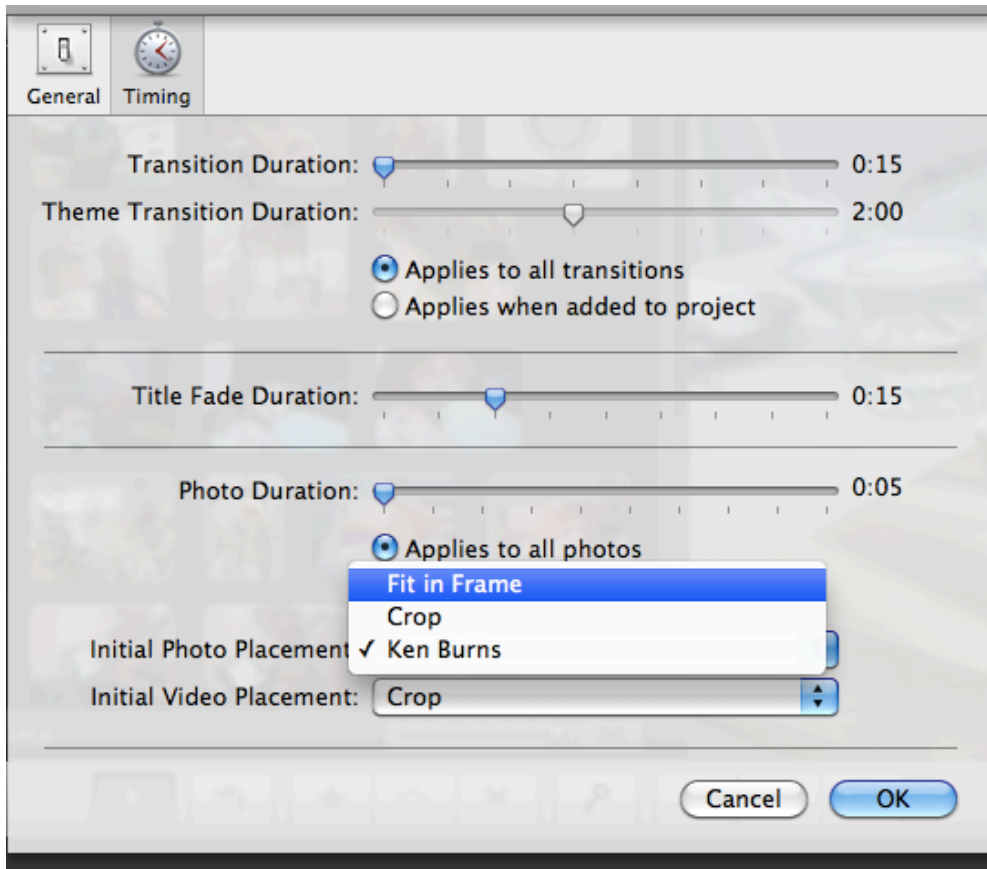
Click on Create.



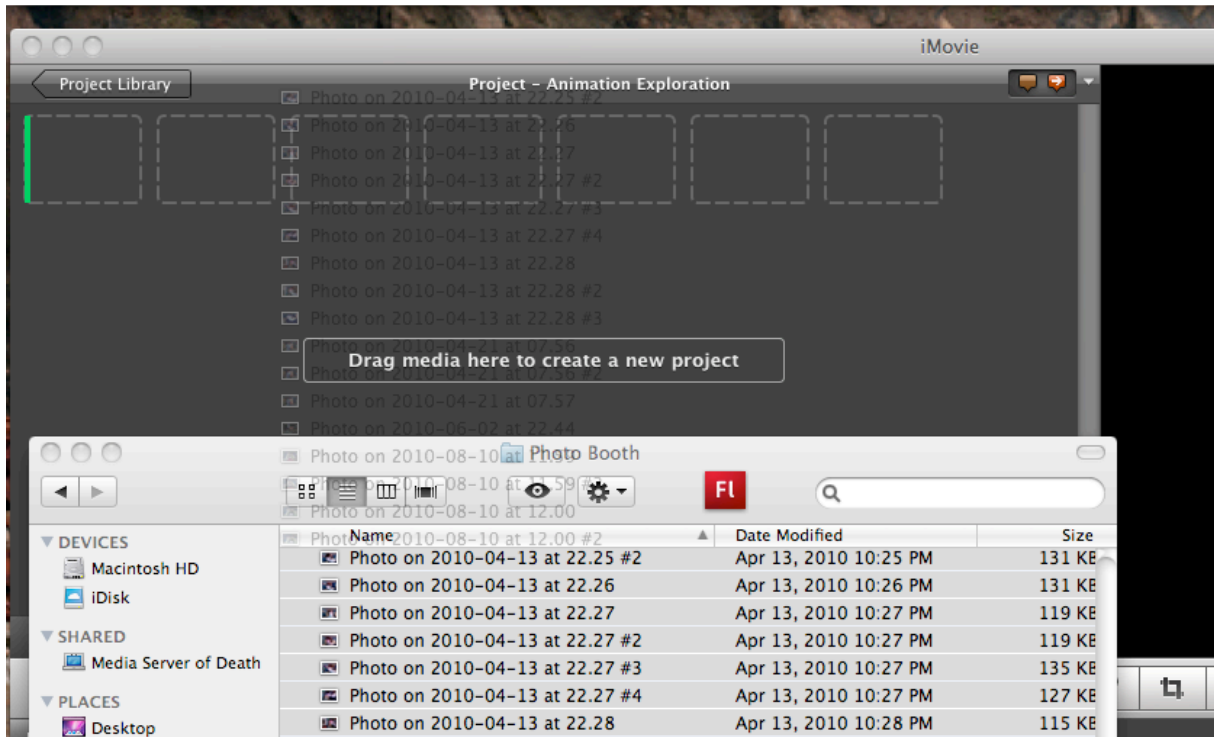
Before you bring any images in, set the Project Properties.
From the File Menu, select Project Properties.



Select the Timing tab at the top of the new window.
Select Fit in Frame for the Initial Photo and Video Placement.

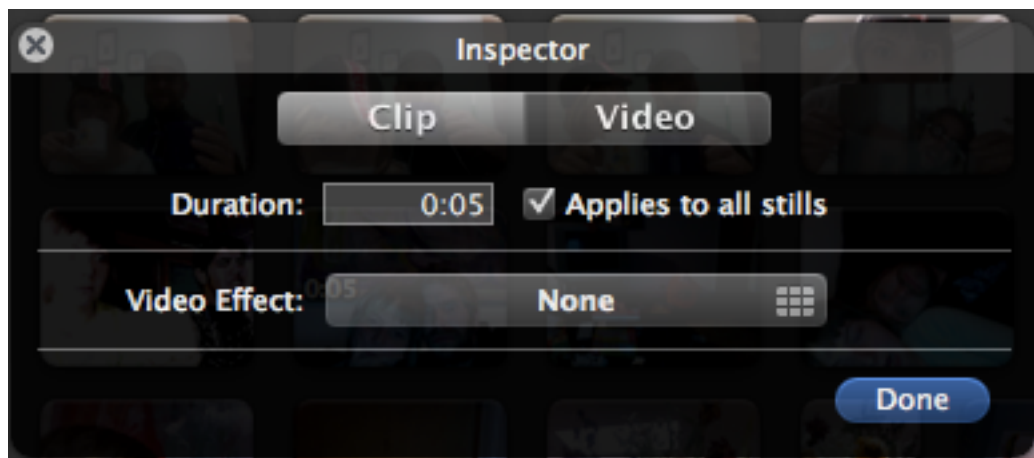


Open a finder window and locate your images. Select them all together and drag them into the iMovie window.



Double click on the first picture and the inspector window will open up. Change the duration to 0:05 and check the Applies to all box.

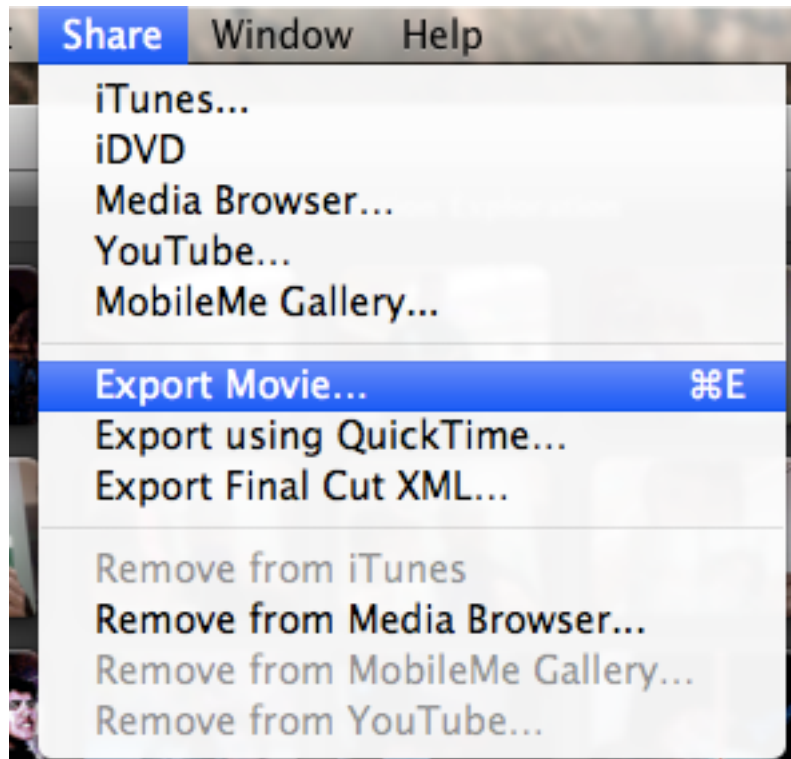

Exporting a Movie

Play the video to make sure it works.

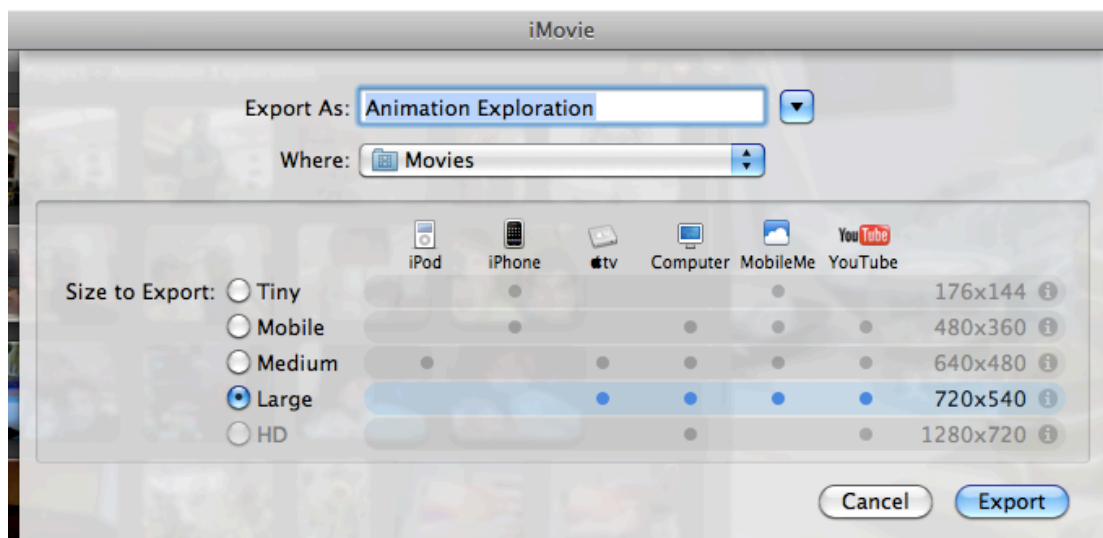
When you're done Select the Share Menu, and the Export Movie.



Keep the same name as your project.

Save the movie to the Movies folder.

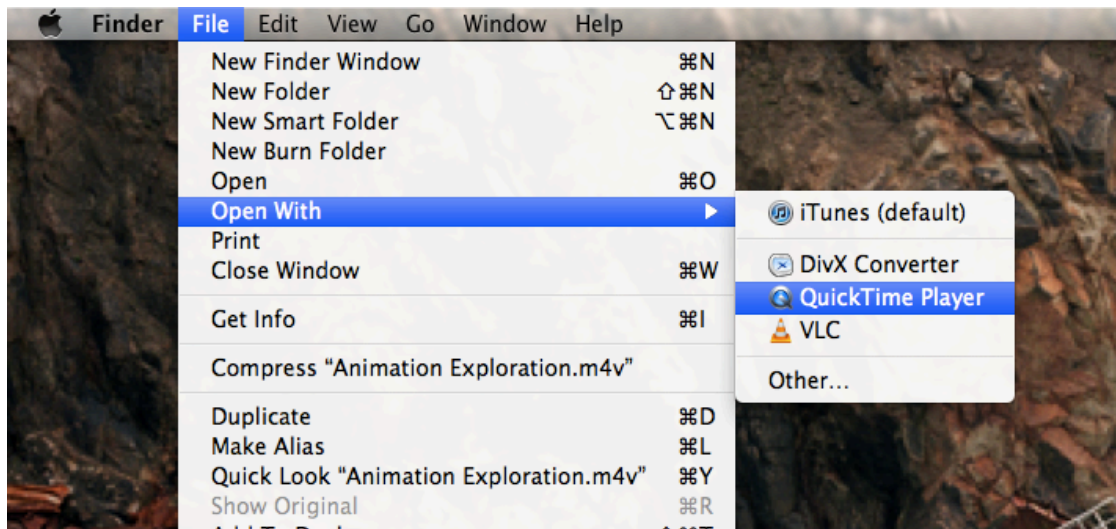
Keep the video size Large.
