

BLACK HISTORY PROJECT

Our class has learned about many influential African Americans that have shaped the way things are today. As a class we choose to study more about Jackie Robinson and how he helped break the color barrier in Major League Baseball. We have researched and found facts about Jackie Robinson in class so that your child can complete a project (chosen from one below) which will be due on their show and tell date next week.

Project Ideas:

Book

Students will create a book that lists 4-5 facts about Jackie Robinson. The book should include major milestones in his life. Make sure the book includes pictures (hand drawn or printed) of that person.

Song

Student will create a song that list facts about Harriet Tubman. The song can follow the same tune as any nursery rhyme or popular song. The song should be about 2-3 stanzas and include facts or characteristics of Jackie Robinson.

Time line

Students will place IMPORTANT events in Jackie Robinson's life in chronological order. You are allowed to use pictures form the internet or draw your own pictures. Students should have at least 4-5 events

Mobile

Students will create a mobile with Jackie Robinson at the top and pictures of things that represent him hanging from it. Be sure to include at least 4-5 things.
