

BLACK HISTORY PROJECT

Our class has learned about many influential African Americans that have shaped the way things are today. As a class we choose to study more about Harriet Tubman and how she helped lead others to freedom. We will research and find new facts about Harriet Tubman in class so that we can complete a project (chosen from one below) which will be due on your child's show and tell date next week.

Project Ideas:

Book

Students will create a book that lists 4-5 facts about Harriet Tubman. The book should include major milestones in her life. Make sure the book includes pictures (hand drawn or printed) of that person.

Song

Student will create a song that list facts about Harriet Tubman. The song can follow the same tune as any nursery rhyme or popular song. The song should be about 2-3 stanzas and include facts or characteristics of Harriet Tubman.

Time line

Students will place IMPORTANT events in Harriet Tubman's life in chronological order. You are allowed to use pictures form the internet or draw your own pictures. Students should have at least 4-5 events

Mobile

Students will create a mobile with Harriet Tubman at the top and pictures of things that represent her hanging from it. Be sure to include at least 4-5 things.
