MONTHLY Objectives

English Language arts (ELA): Students begin to learn key literacy strategies including inferring, compare and contrasting, and making connections. We will also be introduced to HFW A, the, is, for, me, see, an, at, I, am, you, can, be, he, she, we, and, are, like, likes.

Math: Students will count and represent quantities and collections fluently to 10. Also, we will compare quantities and collections fluently to 10 while using multiple models to develop number sense.
