



On Saturday, April 7, 2012, the Red Deer Advocate is proud to again present **Creative ADventures**, an annual students' newspaper supplement that is written and produced entirely by students in the Red Deer and Central Alberta school systems, in co-operation with the Red Deer Advocate.

As in years past, students (from registered classes only) will design creative and effective advertisements for participating local businesses. Each class will have a business assigned to them by the Advocate. We ask that teachers submit the entries of all of their students. The businesses will then choose the ad they would like to have in the section.

In addition, all students are encouraged to submit other random pieces of artwork or any of their creative writing pieces (either poetry or prose) limited to 400 words. REGISTRATION IS NOT NECCESARY if submitting general artwork. Teachers are asked to register their classes in order to participate in the ad design portion of this supplement.

### **For 2012, we will be awarding prizes differently!**

Rather than offering prizes to individual students, we will now award prize packages to winning classrooms. The winning entries will be chosen by a panel of knowledgeable Advocate staff – winners will be chosen from *all* submitted artwork, not just entries from registered classes. Prizes will be awarded as follows:

**These prizes will be gift certificates of varying amounts for teachers to use to purchase supplies for their class or school.**
