This online resource is compiled by PowerSchool and contains a wealth of information. An account will be set up for you by request; you will then have full access to the videos, teacher tips, and training resources available.

Click the PowerTeacher tab, then select from the blue bar:

Documentation—User Guide and Reference Notes

Ken O'Connor—how to make the most of your Gradebook and his “15 Fixes” to accurately grade for learning

Videos—short videos to highlight features of PowerTeacher.

Suggest Enhancements—a place for you to comment and make suggestions to PowerSchool's

Teacher Tips—What every teacher should know. Compiled by teachers, for teachers.

Solutions—Apparently a fairly new feature, suggests solutions for dilemmas faced by districts.

PowerTeacher Forums—read to see what others have contributed

Click the Training tab, then select from the blue bar:

Mastery in Minutes—short videos created to focus on one or two skills

or

Distance Learning—longer videos created to focus on a section of PowerSchool.

Use the Search text entry to type in a key word or words to help you find the information you are searching for.
