








SOUNDSCAPE – JOURNEY TO THE MOON

SYMBOL	REPRESENTATION	SUGGESTED SOUND EFFECTS
10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 LIFT OFF! 	Launch of 'spaceship'	Unison voices shouting countdown Crackling paper, vocal siren going up
	Journey of spaceship (conductor could indicate the speed etc by following the path)	Voices or recorders maintaining a steady drone ,thicker lines indicate rise in volume
	Clouds Size indicates volume	Many students blowing over the top of bottles (or plastic glass/cup can work too)
	Stars	Hand held triangles, jingle bells, jingling keys etc
	Meteorites Size indicates volume	Vocal noises to suggest bumps and bangs, drums (or substitutes) pan lids, anything that makes thuds and clangs
	Aliens Size indicates volume	Vocal- chattering noises, muttered nonsense words, pitch changes Fingernails on blackboard, other horrid noises!
	Time warp	All instruments used, voices sirening round and round
	Space dust storm	Home-made rain sticks, sand paper rubbed together
	Moon landing	Words to suggest soft thud (like DUFF, DUFF) Many fists gently and rapidly hitting wooden desk
