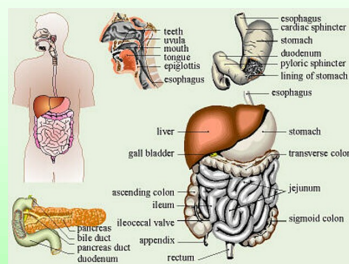

Last Week:

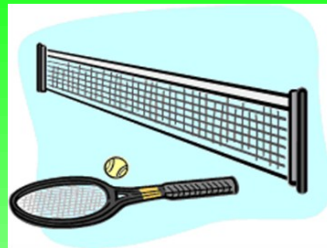
Kim Clijsters from Belgium won the Doha WTA Championships Cup 2010.
